



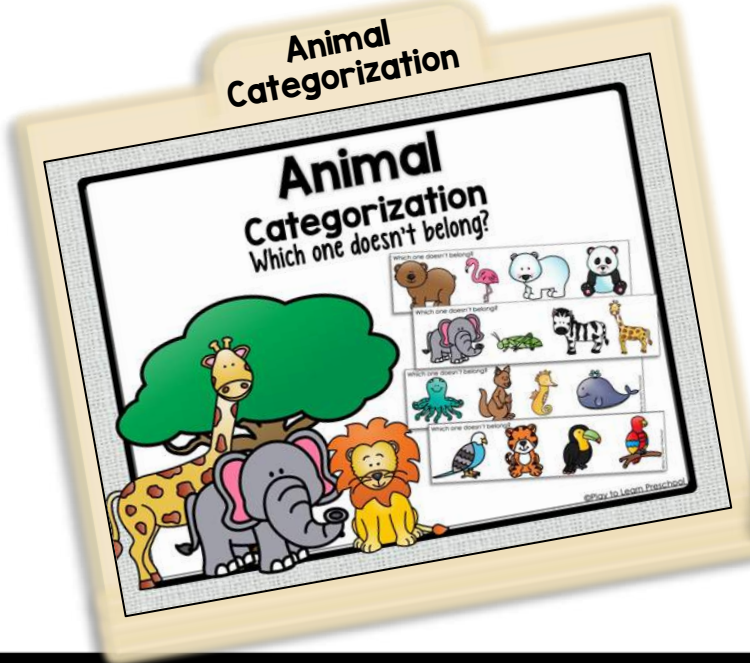
File Folder Games

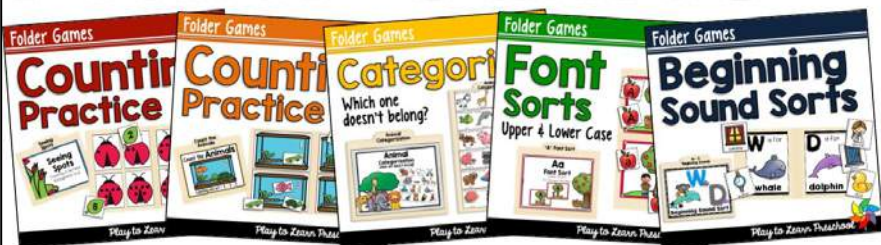
