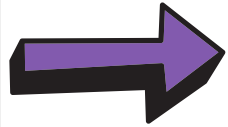

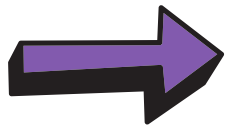

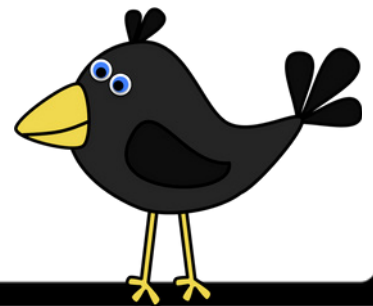

Trains

All about trains

Trains can transport people and cargo along rail tracks.

Objectives:

- The students will express themselves orally.
- The students will respond to others' comments and questions.

Activities:

1. Show the real pictures of trains and discuss.
2. Take a poll. Students use name cards or post-it notes to "vote" for their answers on a bar graph. Have you ever traveled on a train?
3. Sing the T-R-A-I-N song in the tune of "Bingo."
 - Display the letters t-r-a-i-n and sing the song.
 - After singing the song for the first time, cover up the letter t with a picture of the train conductor. Sing the second verse as "choo-r-a-i-n."

Extension Idea:

Teach the ASL sign for **train**. Put 2 fingers together on both hands. Slide fingers from one hand over the fingers from the other hand like the fingers are the track and the train.

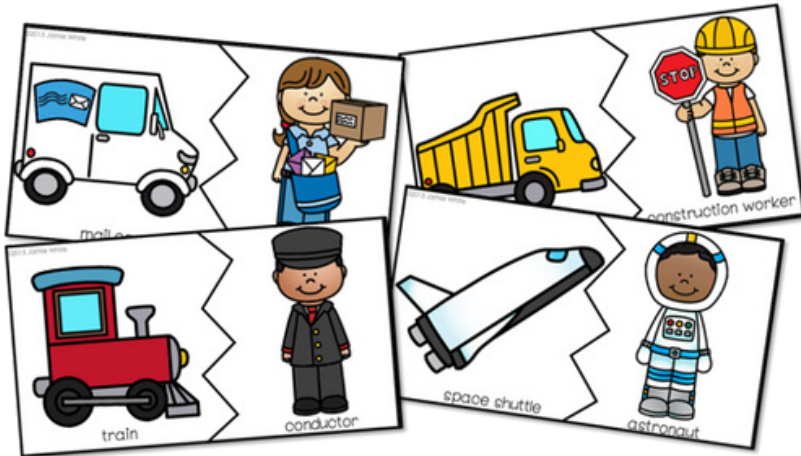

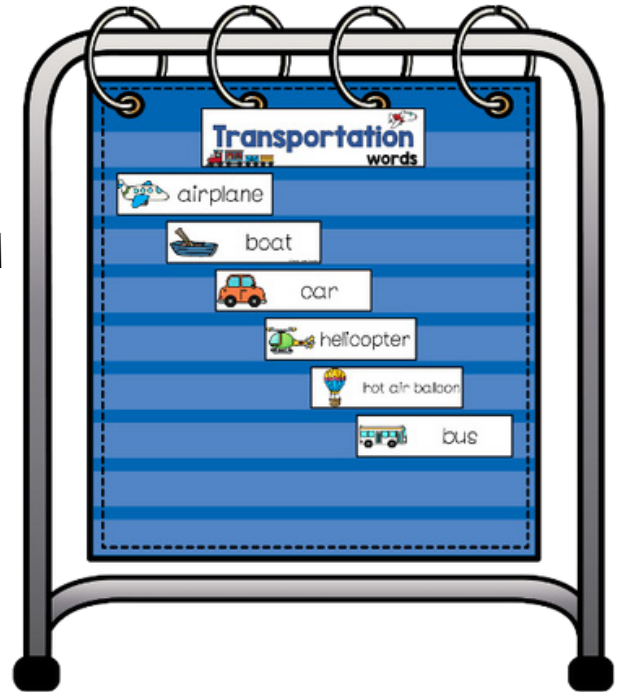

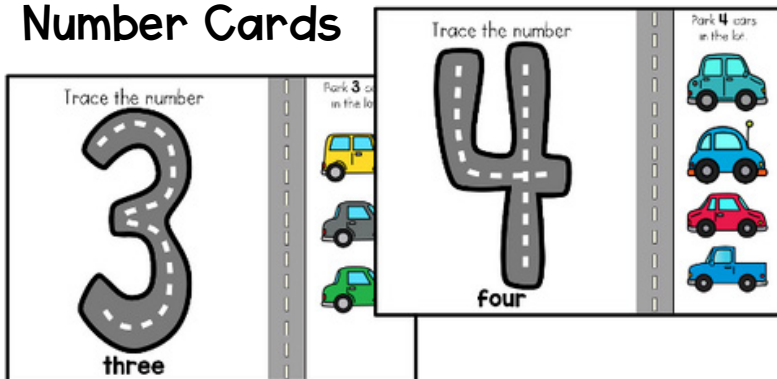
