

Objectives:

- The students will express themselves orally.
- The students will respond to others' comments and questions.

Activities:

- 1. Show the real pictures of trains and discuss.
- Take a poll. Students use name cards or post-it notes to "vote" for their answers on a bar graph. Have you ever traveled on a train?
- 3. Sing the T-R-A-I-N song in the tune of "Bingo."
 - Display the letters t-r-a-i-n and sing the song.
 - After singing the song for the first time, cover up the letter
 <u>t</u> with a picture of the train conductor. Sing the second
 verse as "choo-r-a-i-n."




Meet Jamie
