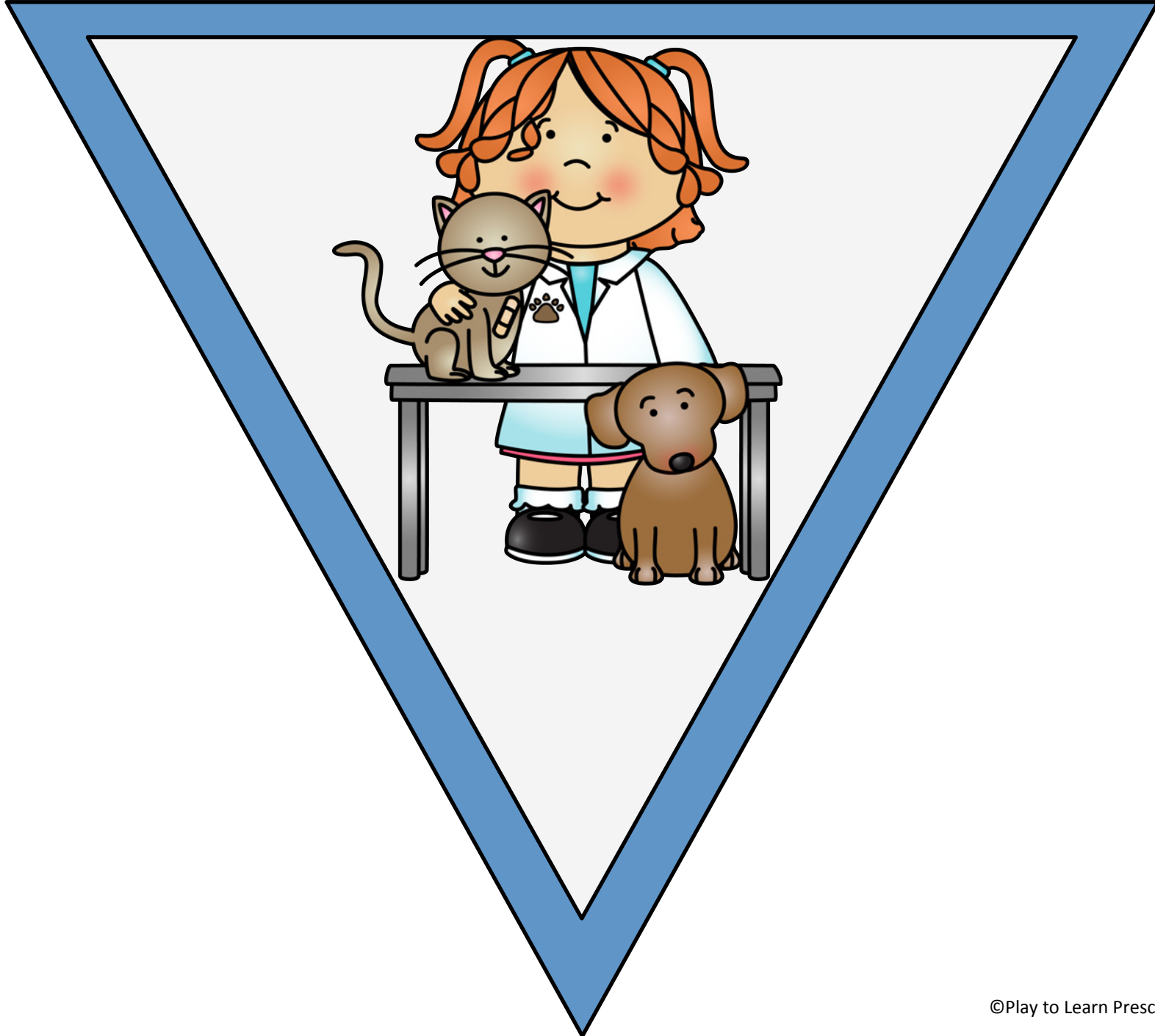


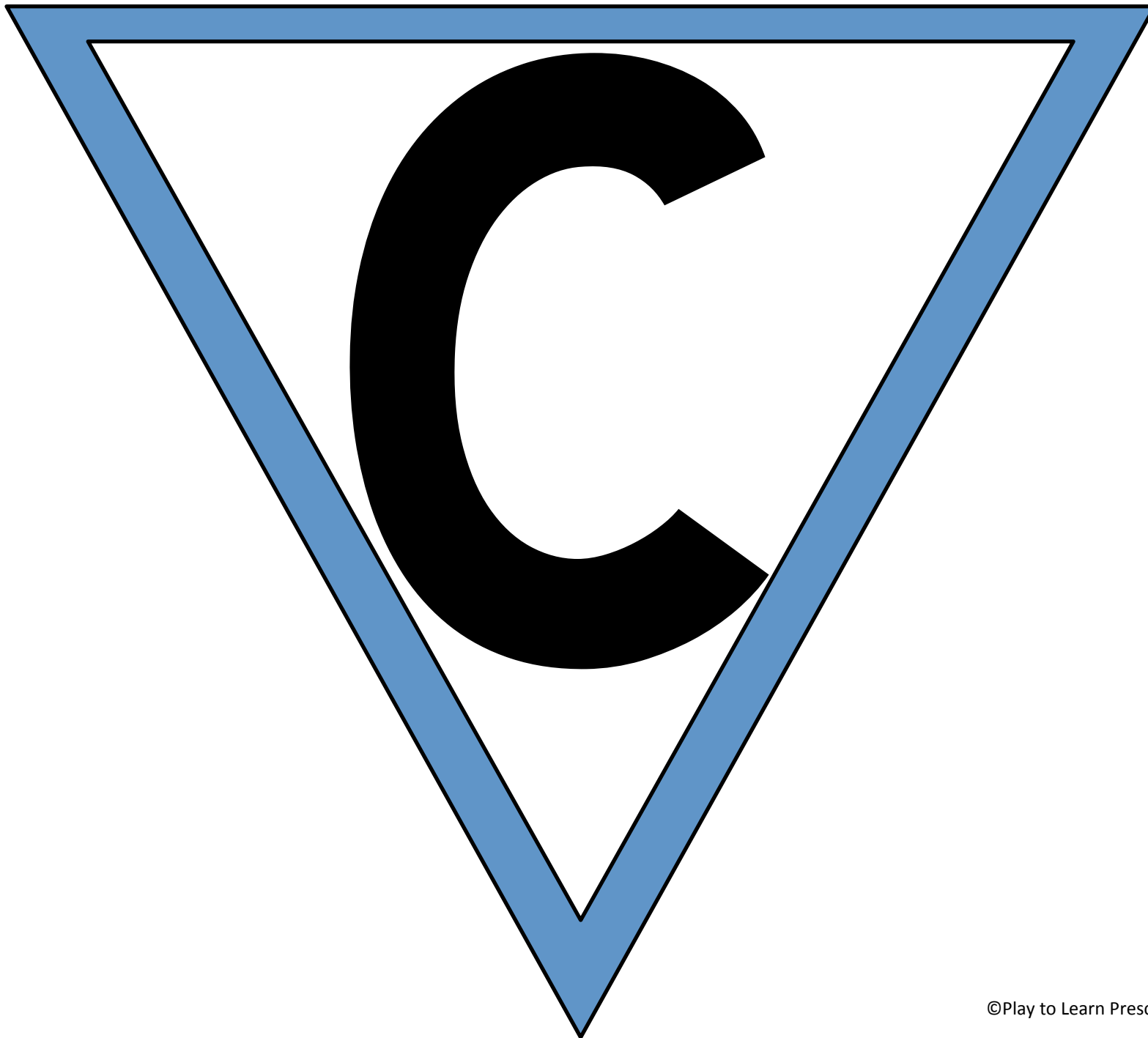


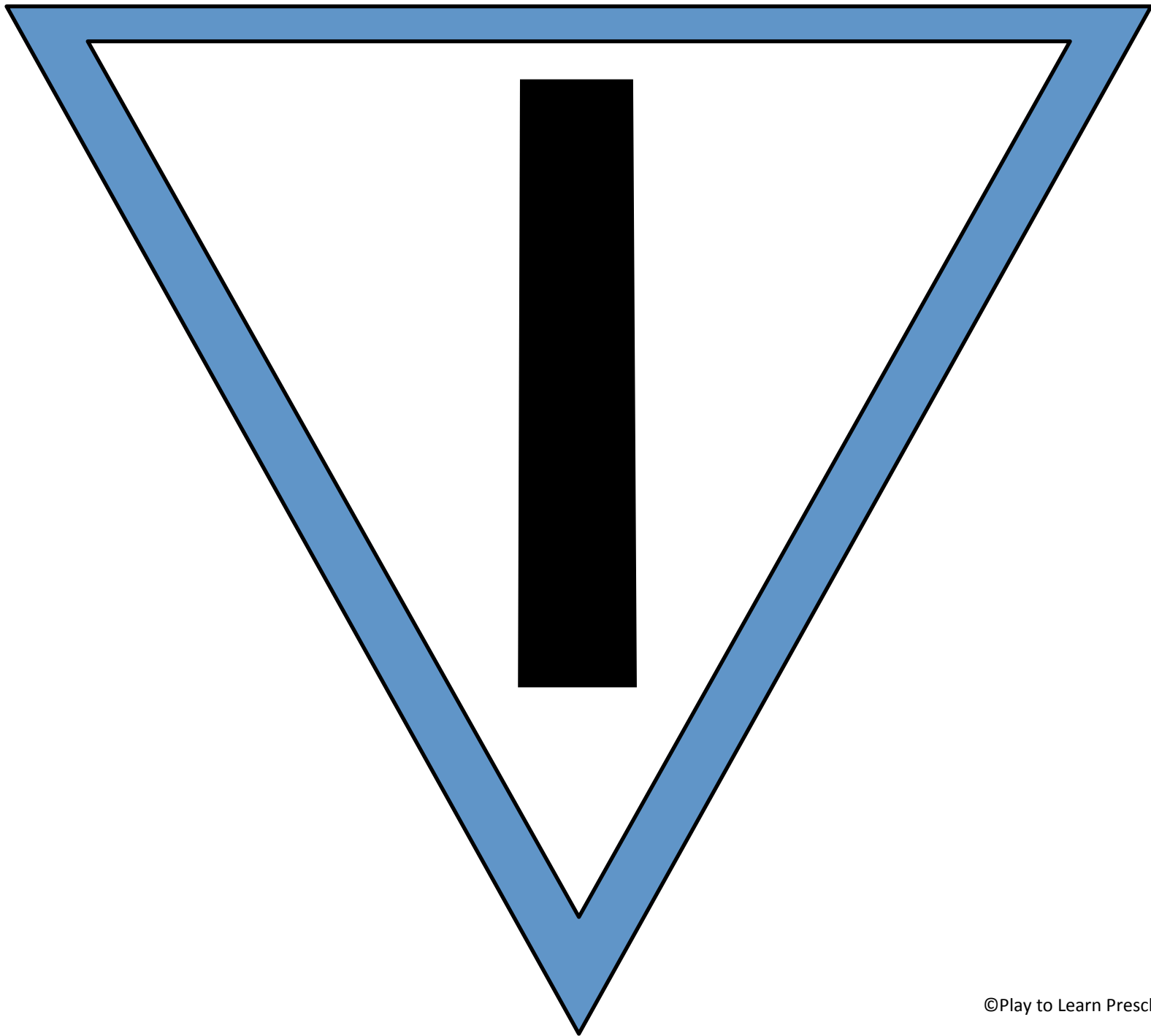


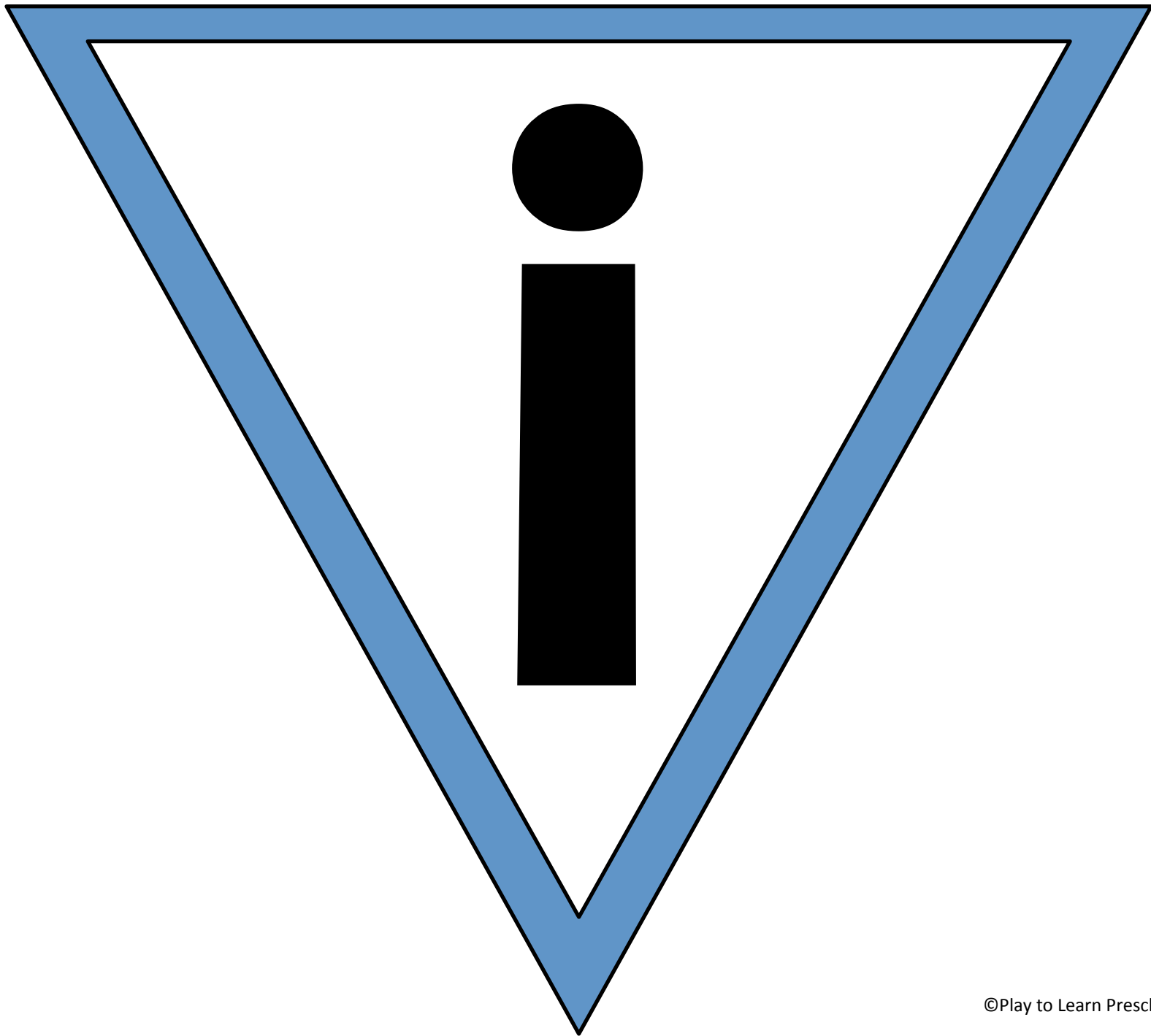


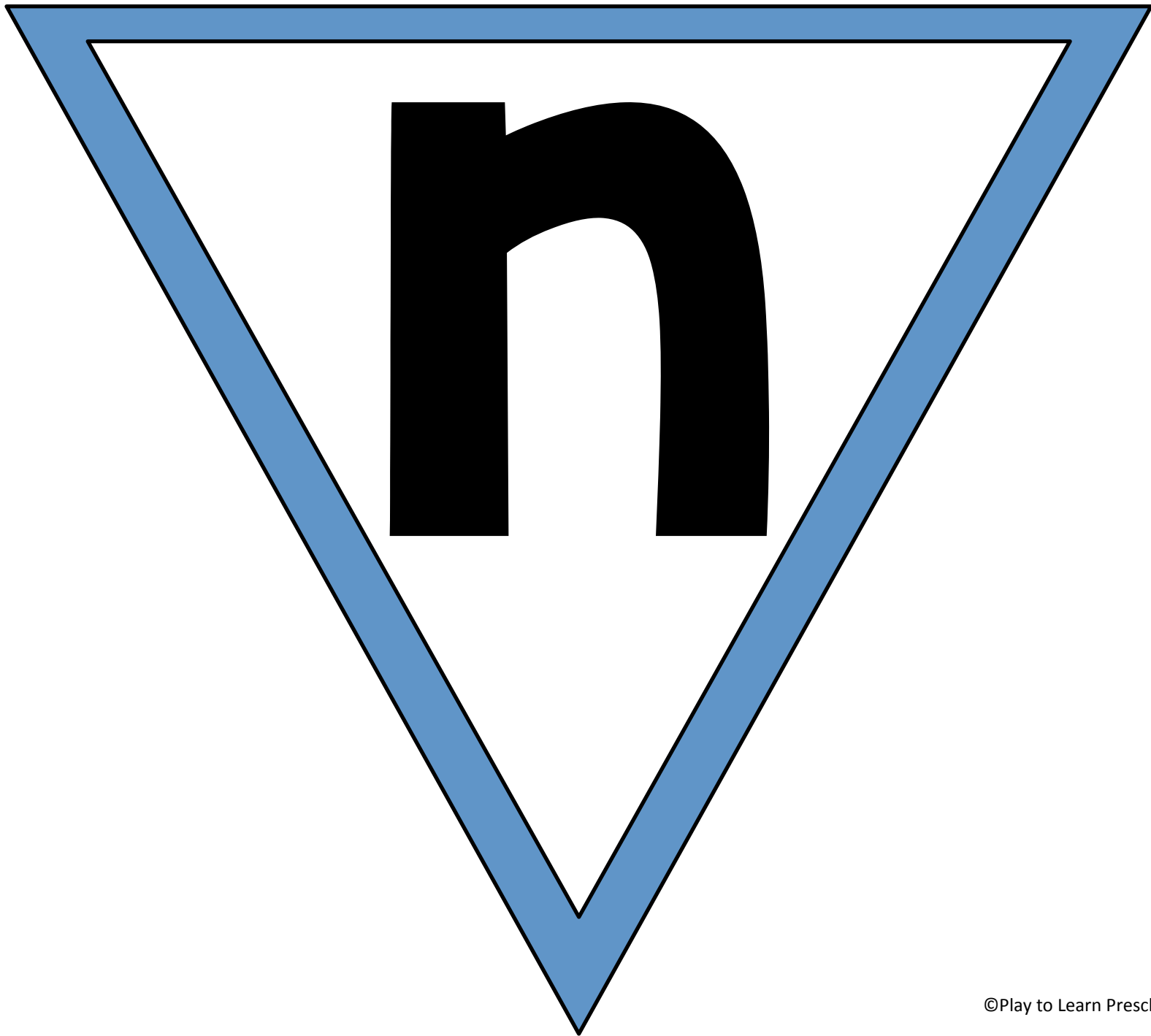


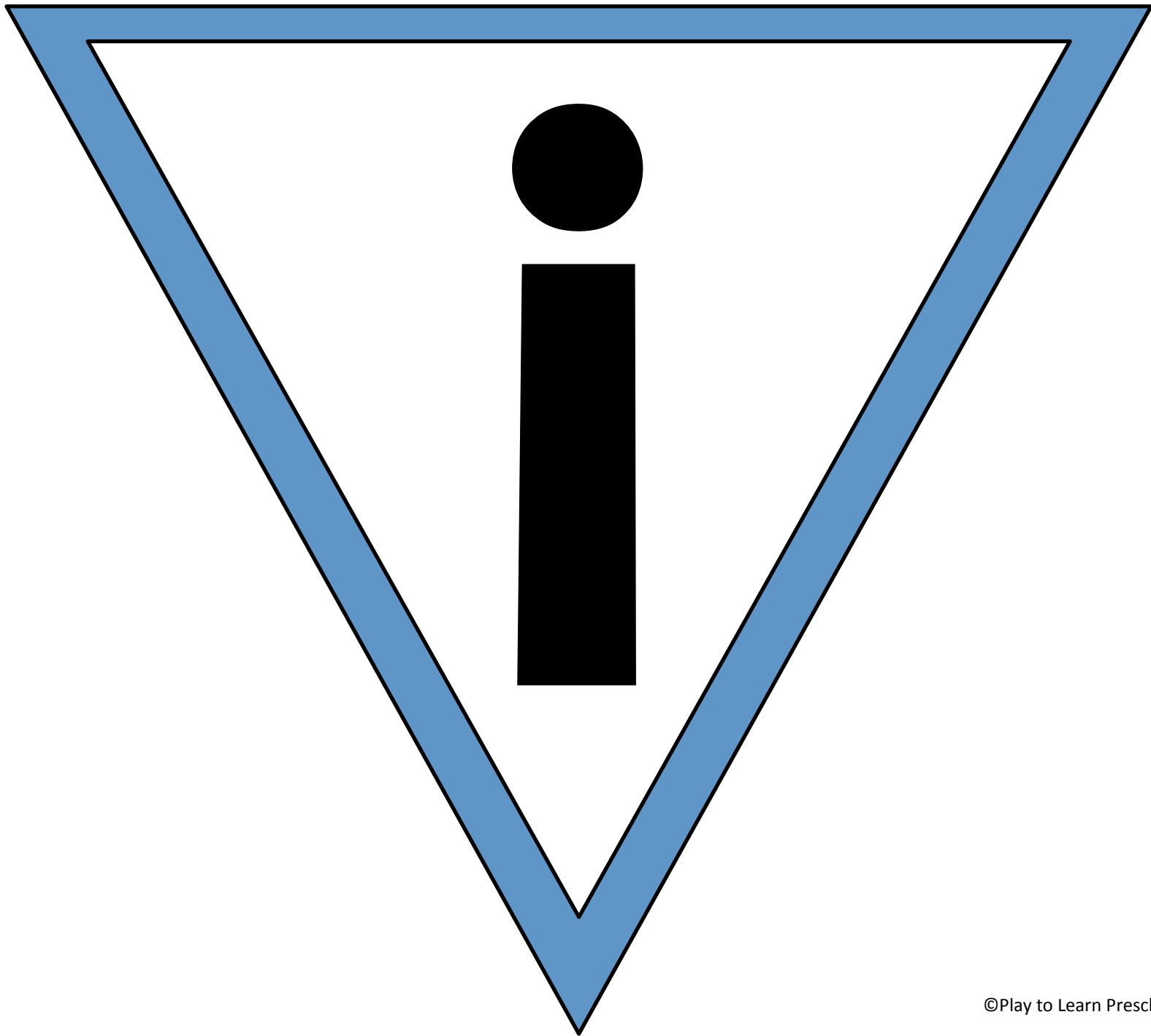


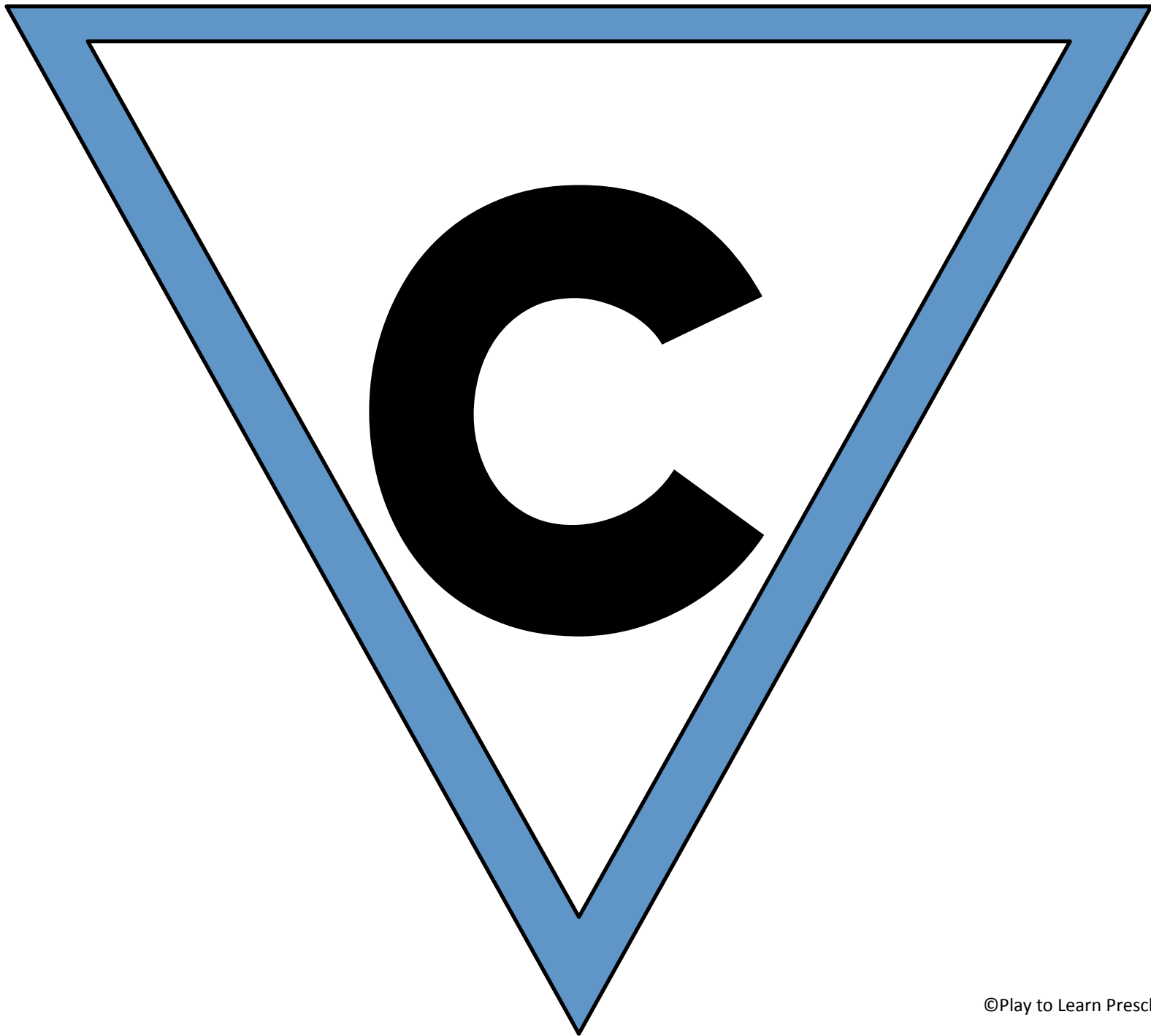


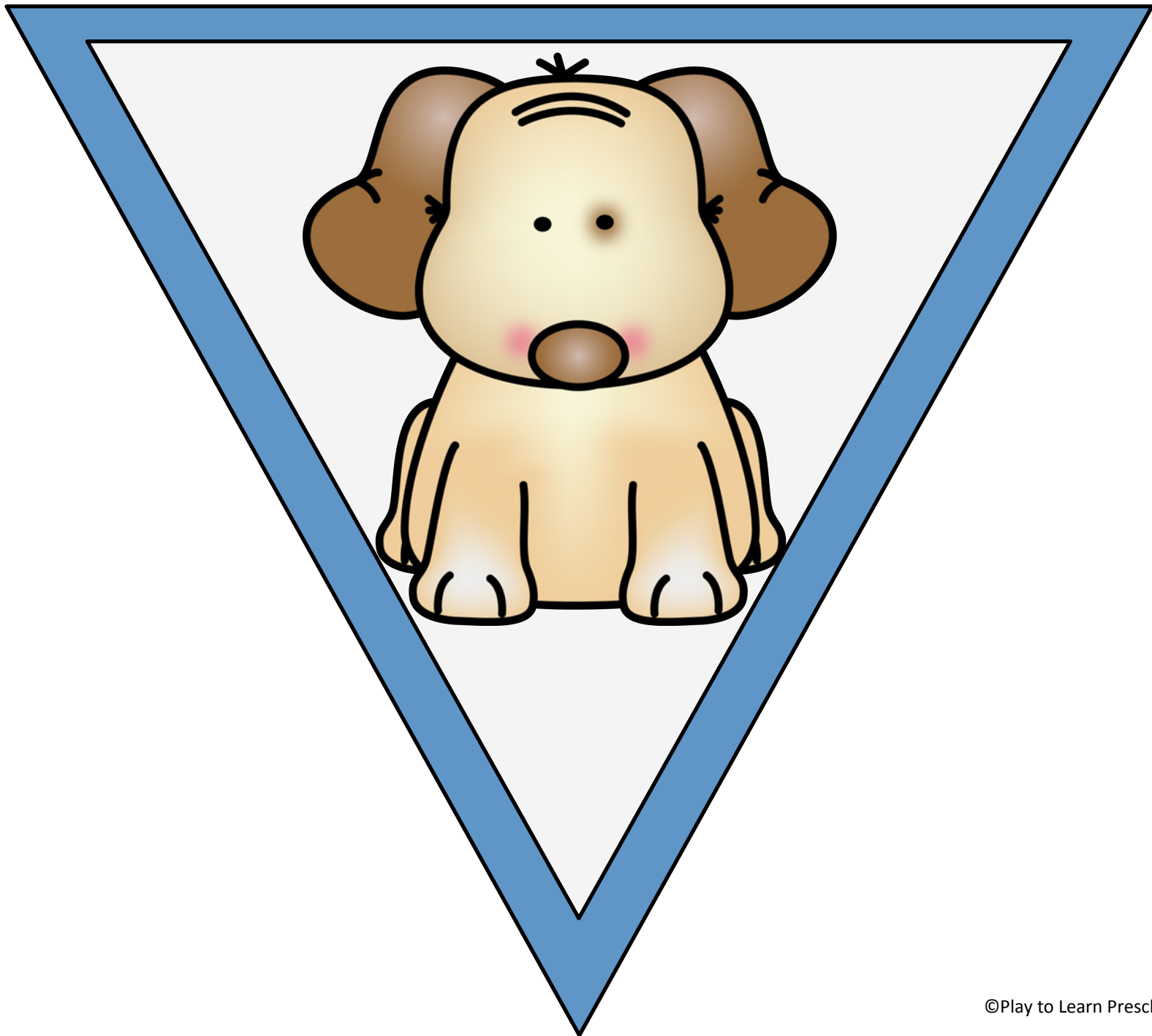




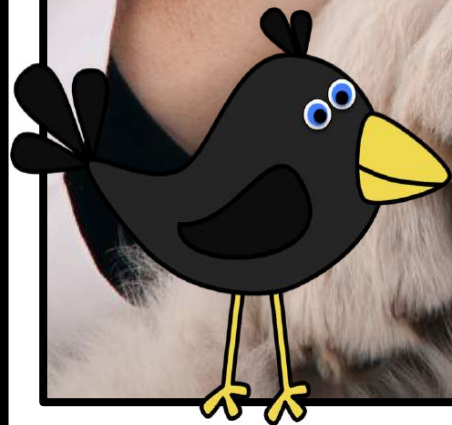








Betsy Goes to a
