Literacy Center

This is an indicator of children's understanding of the relationship between the sound of a letter and the connection to printed words.

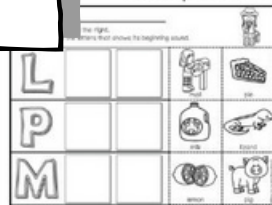
Objective:

Students will begin to make letter-sound connections.

Procedure:

1. Print, out, and laminate the letter and candy cards.
 2. Place letters on a table and the candy in a bag. Students pull out the candy pictures, one at a time, and sort them to their corresponding letter.
- Alternatively, provide Halloween candy buckets and write each letter on the front of the bucket. Put the pictures in empty candy bags. Students will pick a card out of the candy bag and place it in the corresponding bucket.

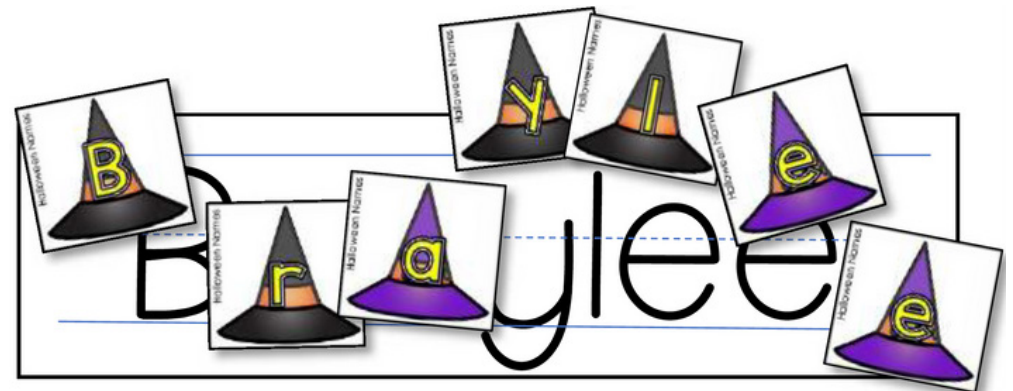
