A nursery rhyme is a traditional rhyming poem or song. Teaching nursery rhymes to children to develop auditory skills and helps with speech development.

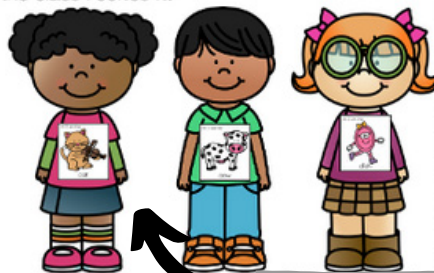
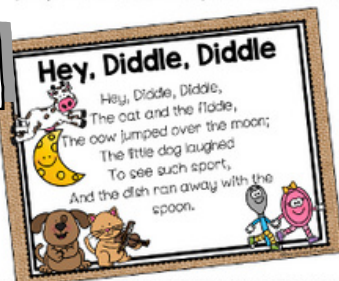
Objective:

Students will develop listening and speaking skills by reciting a poem.

Activities:

1. Read the poem to the students and invite the children to join you in reading it again. Point to each of the characters as you read.
2. Act out the nursery rhyme by assigning the role play name tags to each child. Use props to act out the poem as the rest of the class recites it.

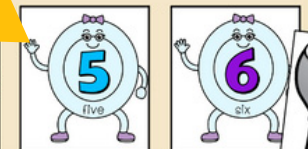
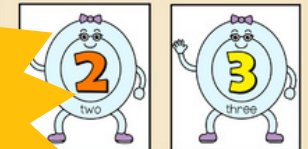
