Jack Be Nimble Nursery Rhyme

Day 1
lesson
plans

A nursery rhyme is a traditional rhyming poem or song. Teaching nursery rhymes helps children to develop auditory skills and helps with speech development.

Objective:

Students will develop listening and speaking skills by reciting a poem.

Activities:

1. Read the poem to the students and invite the children to join you in reading it again.
2. Bring in a candlestick or pretend a block or other small object is a candlestick. Call the students' names one at a time and invite them to jump over it. Replace "Jack" with the student's name.
3. Print the name practice page for each child. Have them write their name three times on the blanks, then practice reading the poem with their own name. Take a photo to attach to the page or invite students to draw a picture of themselves jumping.

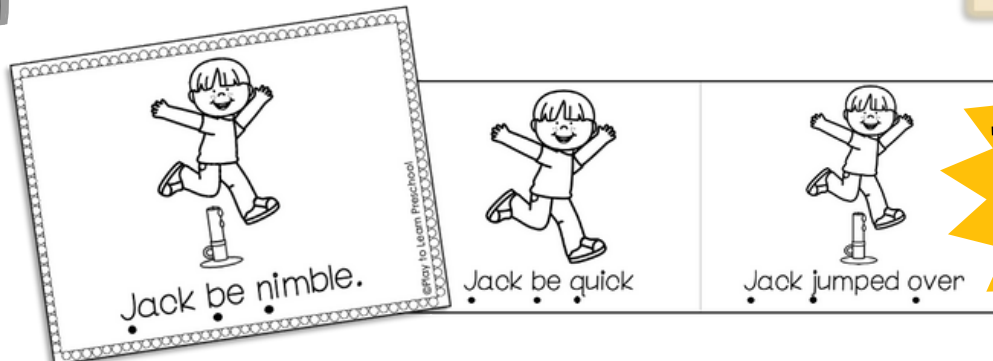

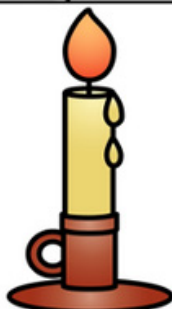

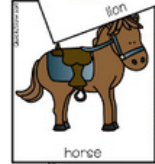
