Little Boy Blue

Nursery Rhyme

Day 1 lesson plans

Little Boy Blue is a traditional rhyming poem or song. Teaching nursery rhymes to children to develop auditory skills and helps with speech development.

Students will develop listening and speaking skills by reciting a poem.

Activities:

1. Print and laminate the cards for each part of the poem.
2. Read the poem to the students and invite the children to join you in reading it again.
3. Hold up the card when that part of the poem is read. Have the students make the sounds shown.
