Nursery Rhyme


Day 1 lesson plans

Row, Row, Row Your Boat is a traditional rhyming poem or song. Teaching nursery rhymes to young children helps to develop auditory skills and helps with speech development.


These activities will develop listening and speaking skills.

Directions:


1. Print, cut, and laminate the action cards.
