Star Light, Star Bright Day 1 lesson plans

Rhyming Word Replacement

Write a memorized poem (like nursery rhymes) and replace words with rhyming words. This activity is an important phonological awareness skill.

Students will play with words, sounds, and rhymes.

Print the poem and picture cards. Mat and laminate if desired. Cut apart the picture cards.

Read the poem with the students using hand gestures like ASL for "star" (day 2 lesson plans). Once the students are familiar with the poem, try using rhyming words to make a silly version. Have the student choose a picture card and recite the nursery rhyme replacing "star" with the rhyming word.
