Teddy Bear, Teddy Bear Day 1 lesson plans
Nursery Rhyme

a traditional rhyming poem or song. Teaching nursery rhymes to develop auditory skills and helps with speech development.

will develop listening and speaking skills by reciting a poem.

Copy, mat, laminate, and cut out the action cards (4 extra cards are included for extended verses.)
Read the poem to the students and invite the children to join you in reading it again.
3. Have the students act out the bear motions:
- Turn around in a circle.
- Touch the ground.
- Pretend to turn off a light.
- Tilt head to the side and pretend to sleep.

Extension Idea:
Use the extra motion cards for extended verses of the Teddy Bear nursery rhyme.





Teddy Bear, Teddy Bear say goodnight!


