Letter Recognition

Letter knowledge is essential to the start of reading and writing. Success in reading is often in connections of understanding the relationship between functions of letters and writing. Develop and strengthen letter knowledge with this engaging game.

Objective: The students will recognize letters of the alphabet.

To Play the Game:

1. Set up the pictures of the mail carts. (All 26 upper and lower-case letters are included. Pick the right number for your students.)
2. Identify the letters together. Hide the Valentine envelope under one of the carts and recite the poem to find it.
3. Children choose a letter and check to see if it's there.

Let's look and see!



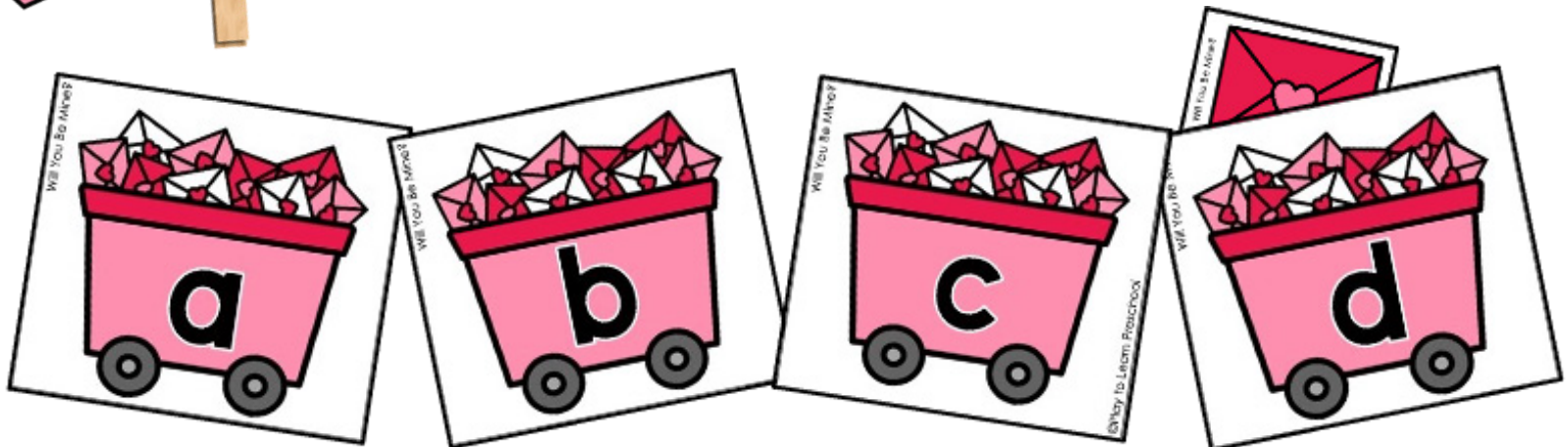
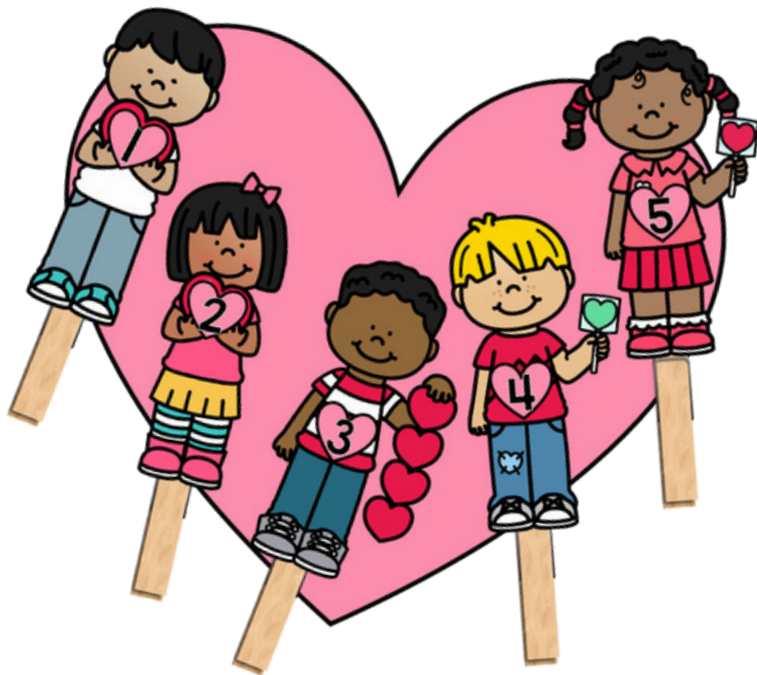
