Recommended:

- scavenger hunt
- clipboards
- dry erase markers

Procedure:

1. Print and cut out the hunt sheet and accompany it with the list of objects.
2. Students search for the objects listed on the sheet.
3. Students bring the objects to the scavenger hunt.

Procedure:

1. Begin a discussion about long and short. What can you think of that is long? Show the student a ruler that is long. Then ask if it is short.
2. Place some objects along with the ruler - objects that are longer than the ruler and shorter than the ruler.

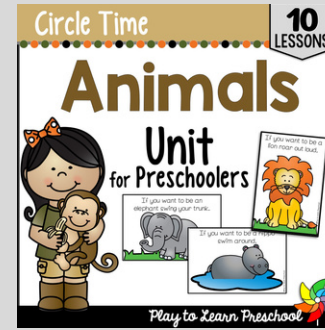
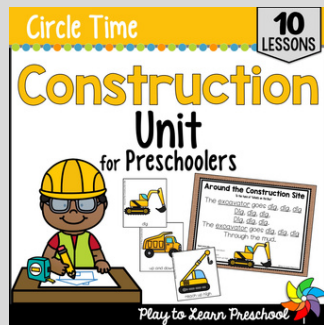
