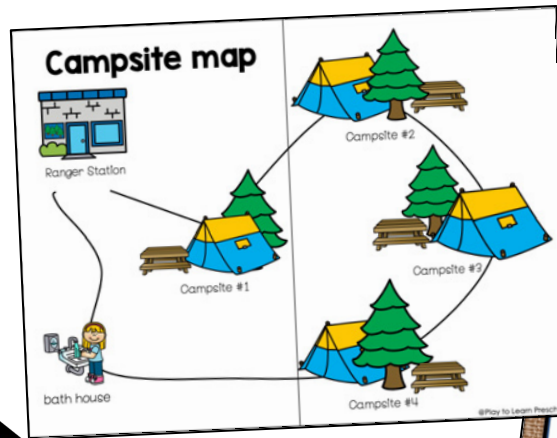

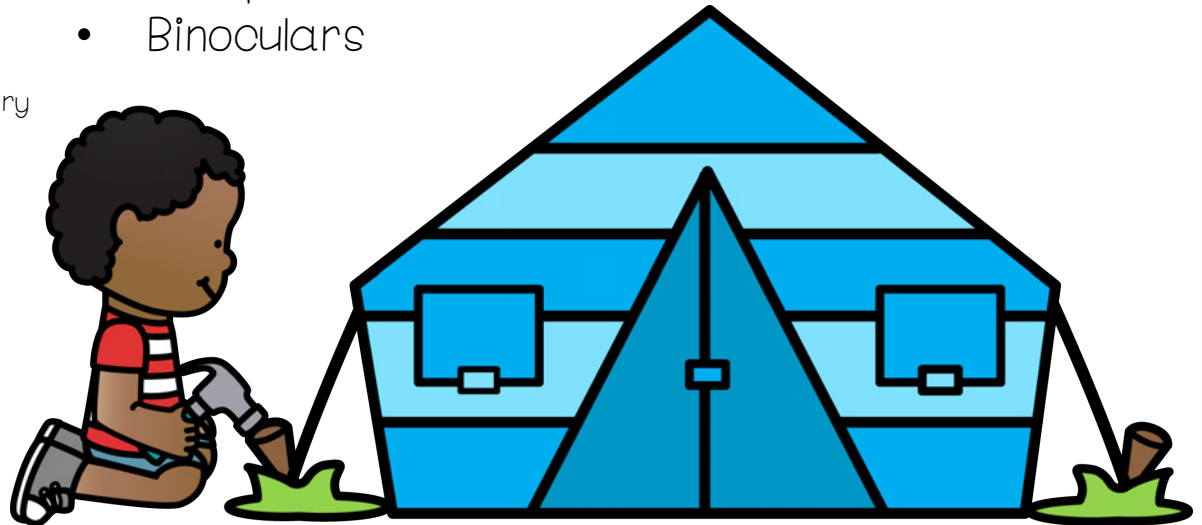
Camping Dramatic Play Center

Gather play tents or sheets and other camping props and set up a campsite in your dramatic play area.

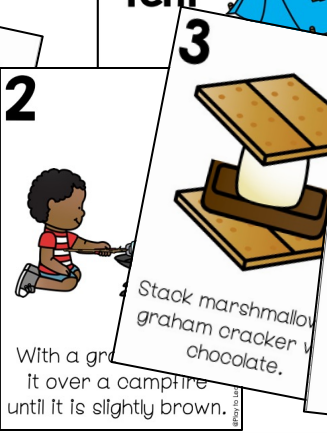
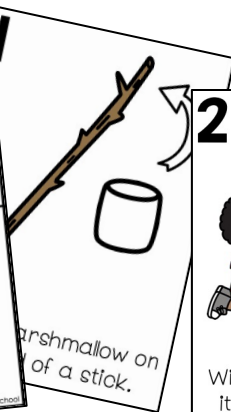
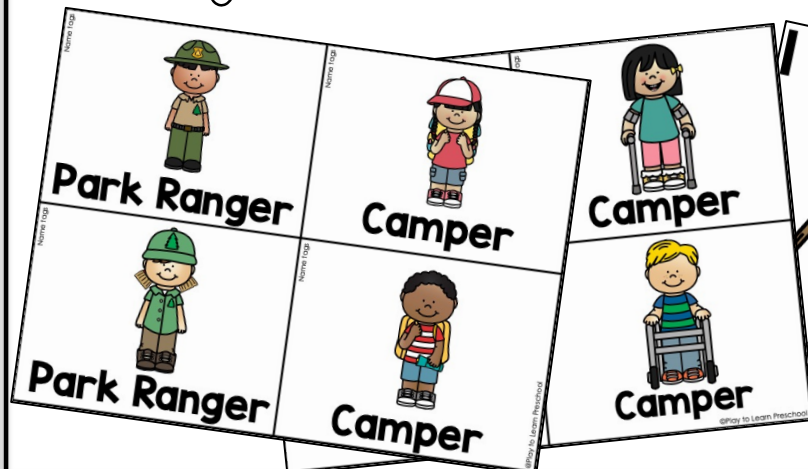
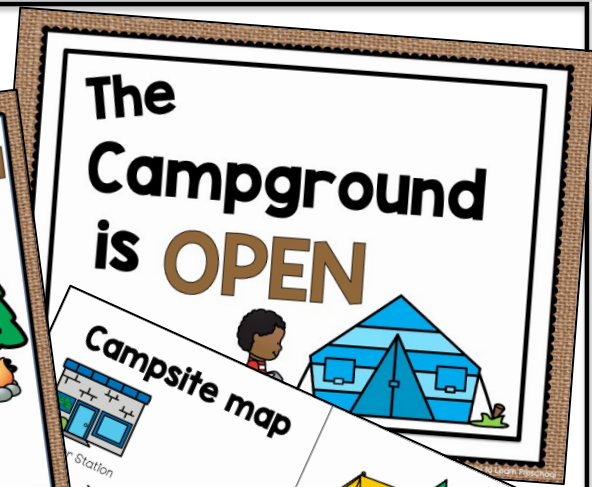
Props:

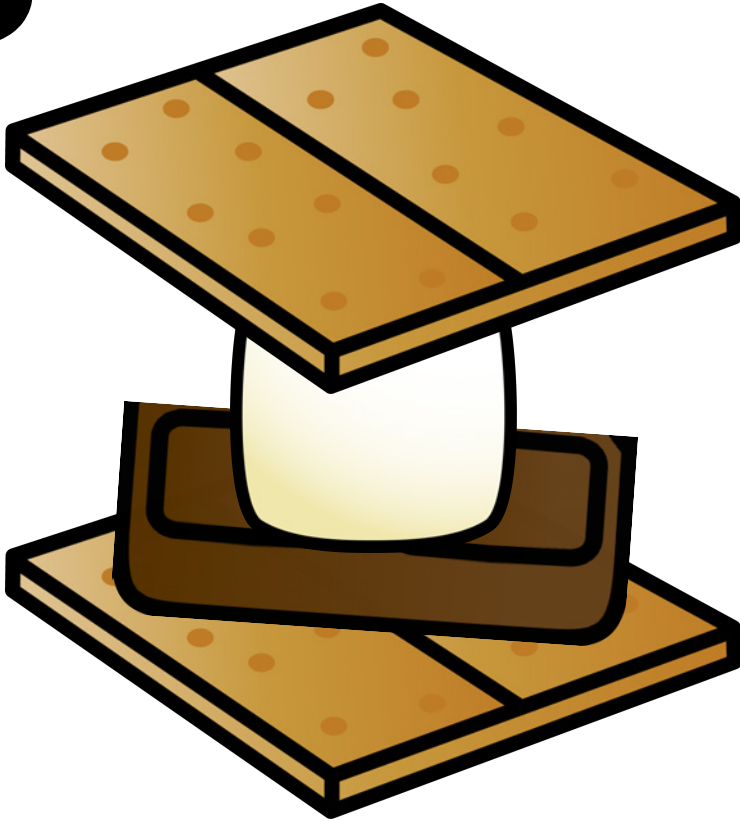
Put a marshmallow on the end of a stick.

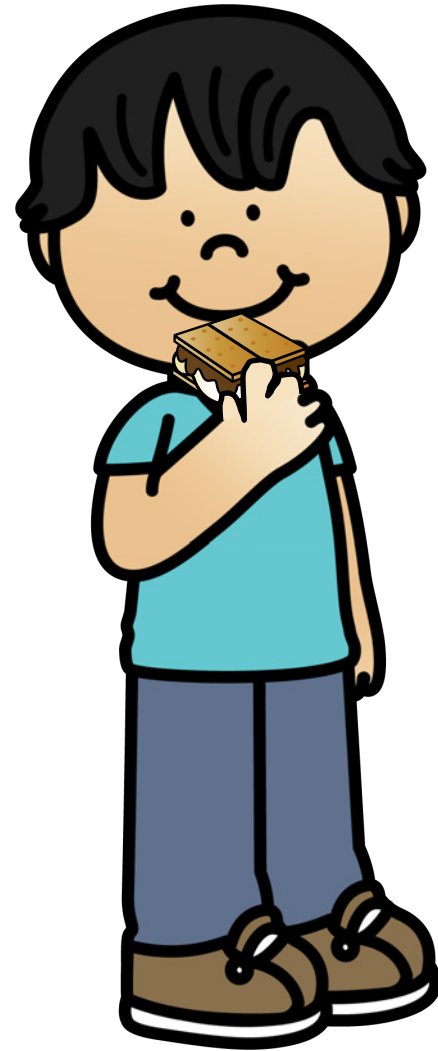
With a grownup, hold it over a campfire until it is slightly brown.

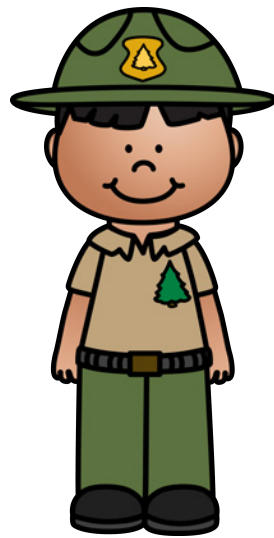
Stack marshmallow on graham cracker with chocolate.
