

## Frog Shape Activities

Hop into shape recognition with these engaging frog-themed shape activities. Preschoolers will practice identifying and matching 2D shapes by placing frogs and flowers with their matching lily pad shapes. These activities build early math skills, supports visual discrimination, and helps develop fine motor coordination.

### Learning Objectives

**Shape Recognition**— Students will identify and match various shapes by pairing frogs, lily pads, and flowers.

**Fine Motor Development**— Students will develop hand strength, coordination, and pre-writing skills as they handle the pieces.

### Preparation:

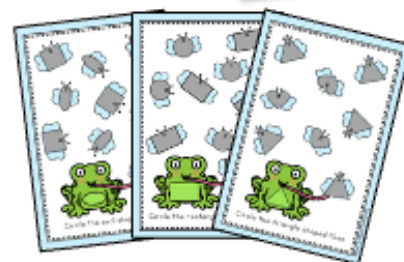
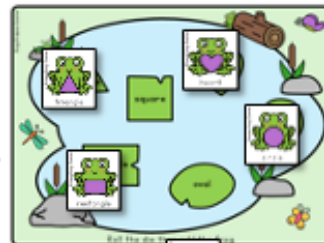
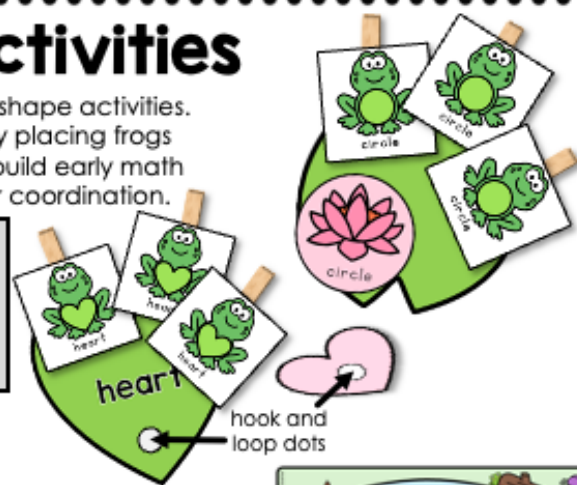
- **Print** the pages on cardstock for durability.
- **Laminate** the pages for reuse.
- **Cut** out the pieces and assemble according to directions on each page. Attach the Frog Shape Sort frogs to clothes pins and affix hook and loop dots to attach the flowers to their coordinating lily pads.

### How to Use:

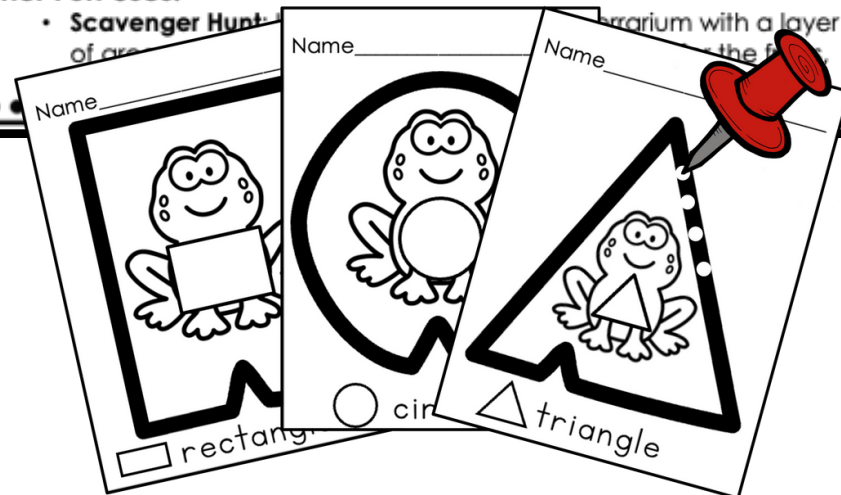
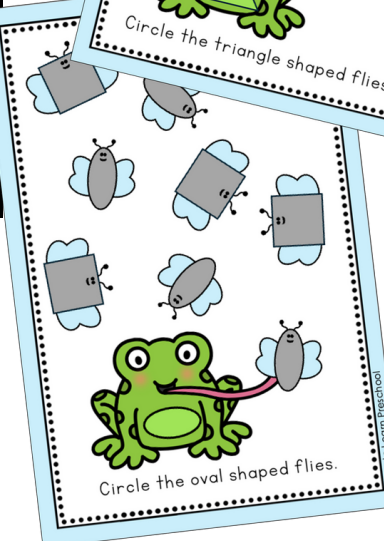
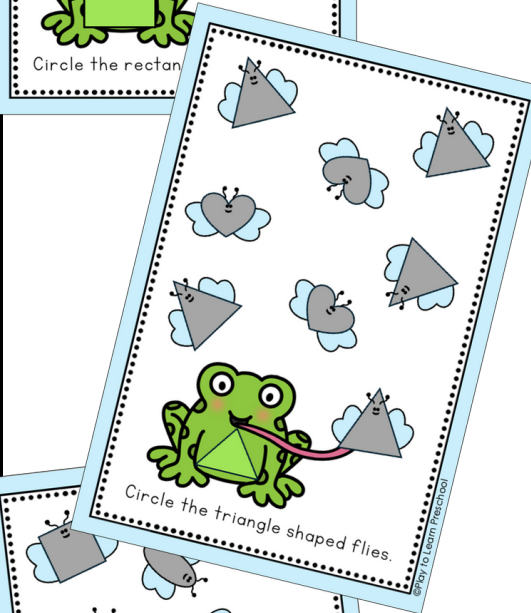
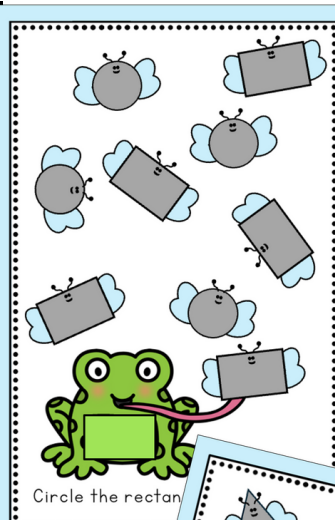
1. **Frog and Lily Pad Shape Match** - Students choose a lily pad then find and attach the matching frogs and flower.
2. **Frog Shapes Game** - Students roll the dice and place that shaped frog on their game mat.
3. **Push Pin Activity** - Students perforate the edge of the shapes using a push pin, golf tee, or toothpick. (\*\*Supervision recommended\*\*)
4. **Shape Search** - Students find and circle the matching shaped flies with a dry erase marker.

- **Scavenger Hunt** - Hide the shapes around the classroom with a layer of...



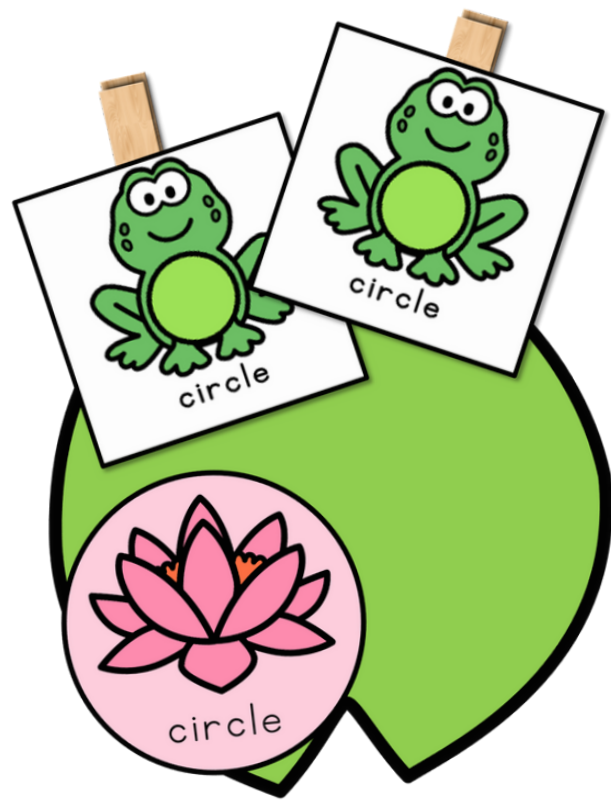
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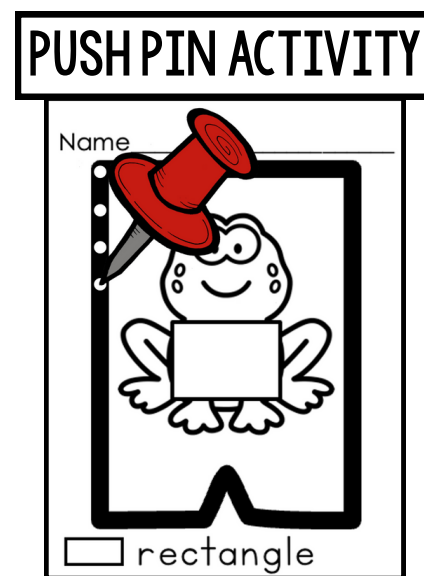
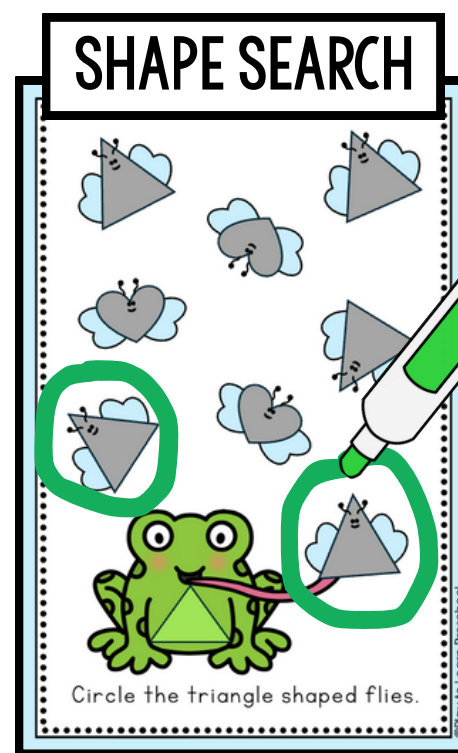
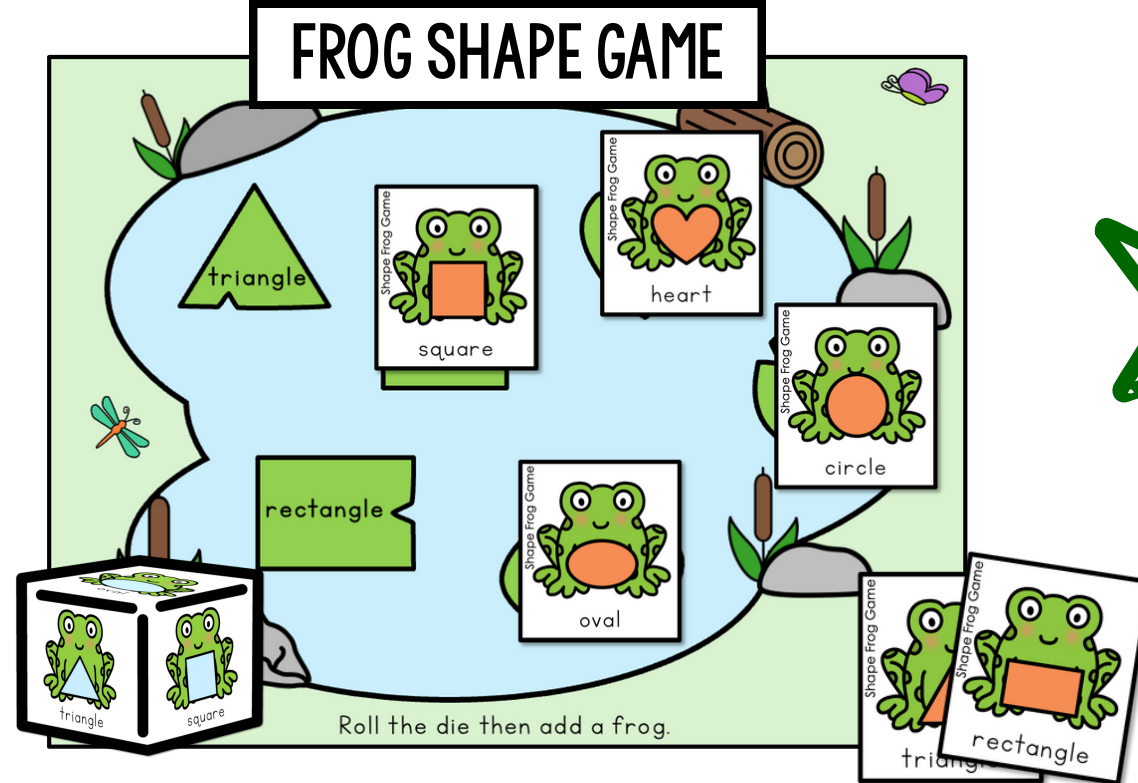
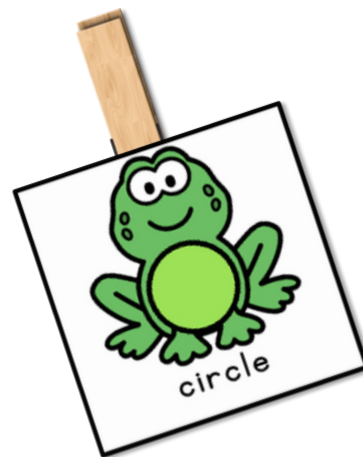

➤ **Fine motor development** – students build fine motor skills by handling game pieces, using push pins, and completing practice sheets.

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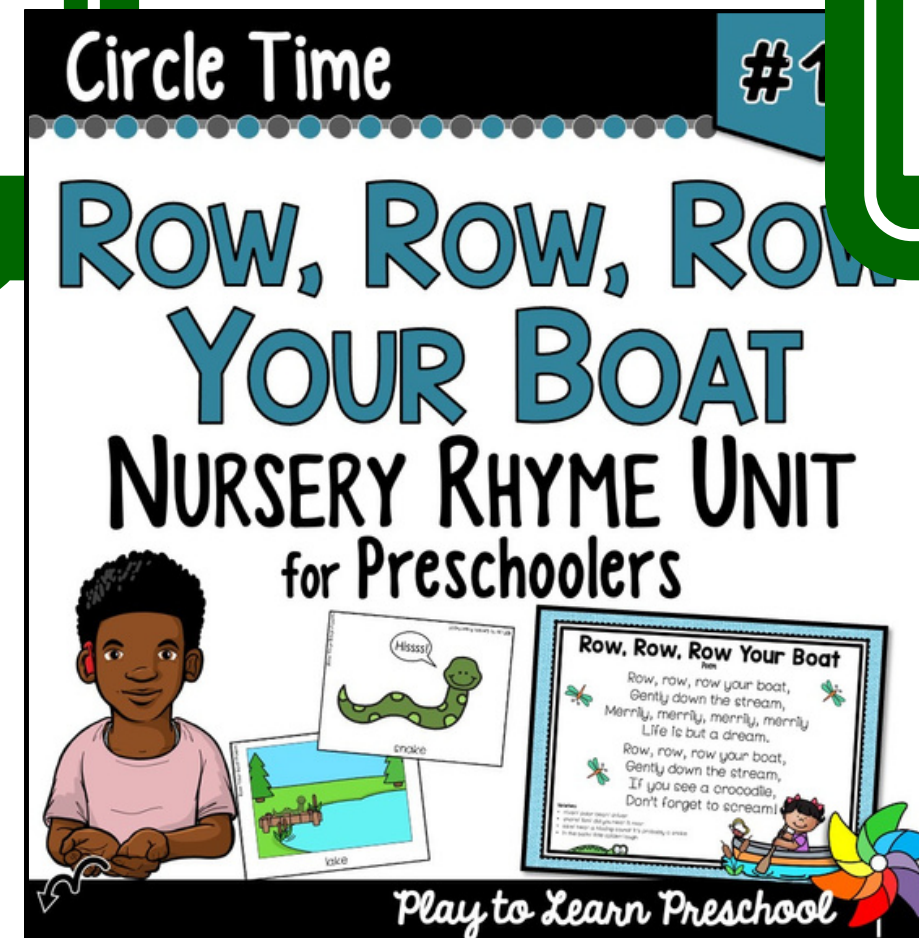
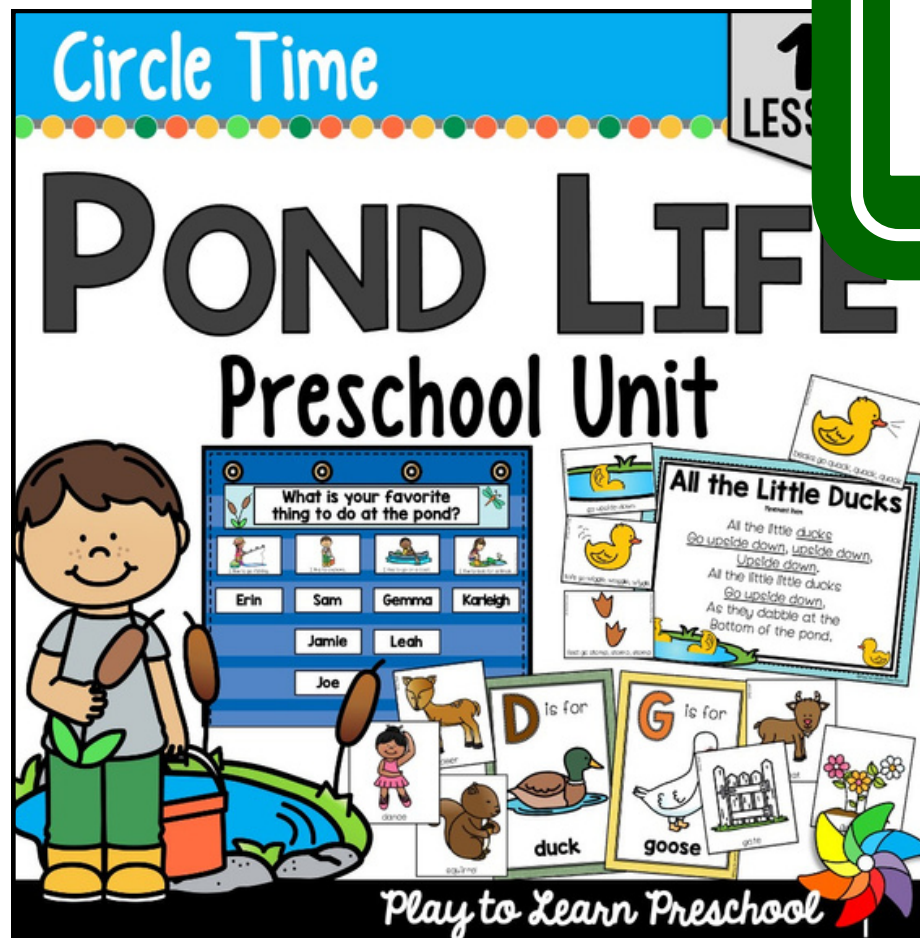
