

## Peek-A-Boo Envelope Game

### To Prepare:

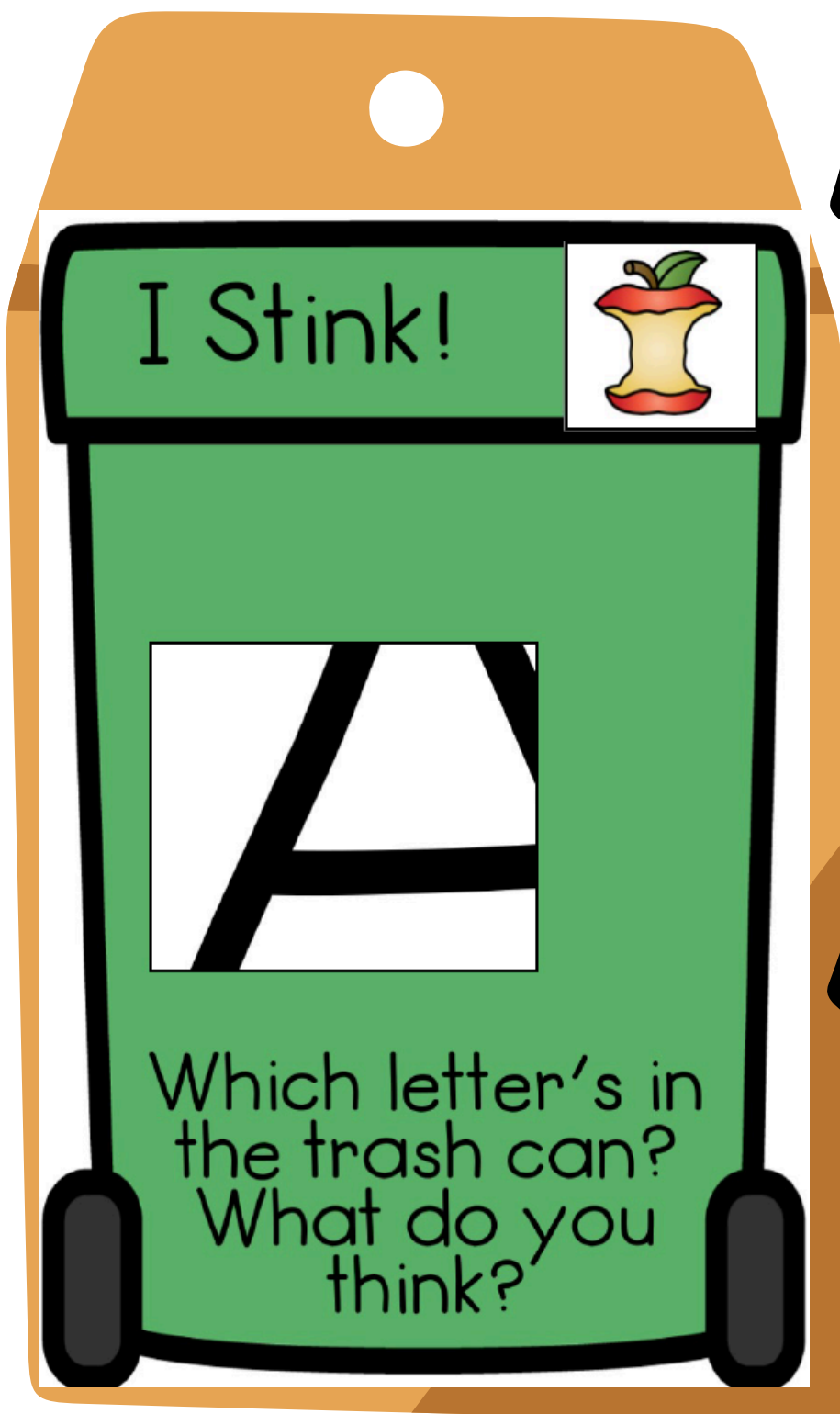
- Print the cards.
- Adhere one green garbage can to the outside of a 6"x9" envelope.
- Cut out the 2 white squares. Cut through the garbage can and 1 layer of the envelope.
- Cut the letter cards apart so that each one is approximately 5.5"x8.5".



### To Play the Game:

- Place one of the letter cards into the envelope so that the students cannot see it.
- Show them the envelope and recite the rhyme: "I stink! Which letter's in the trash can? What do you think?"
- Students use their knowledge of letters and letter sounds to guess which letter is hiding.
- Pull the letter card out to reveal the answer!

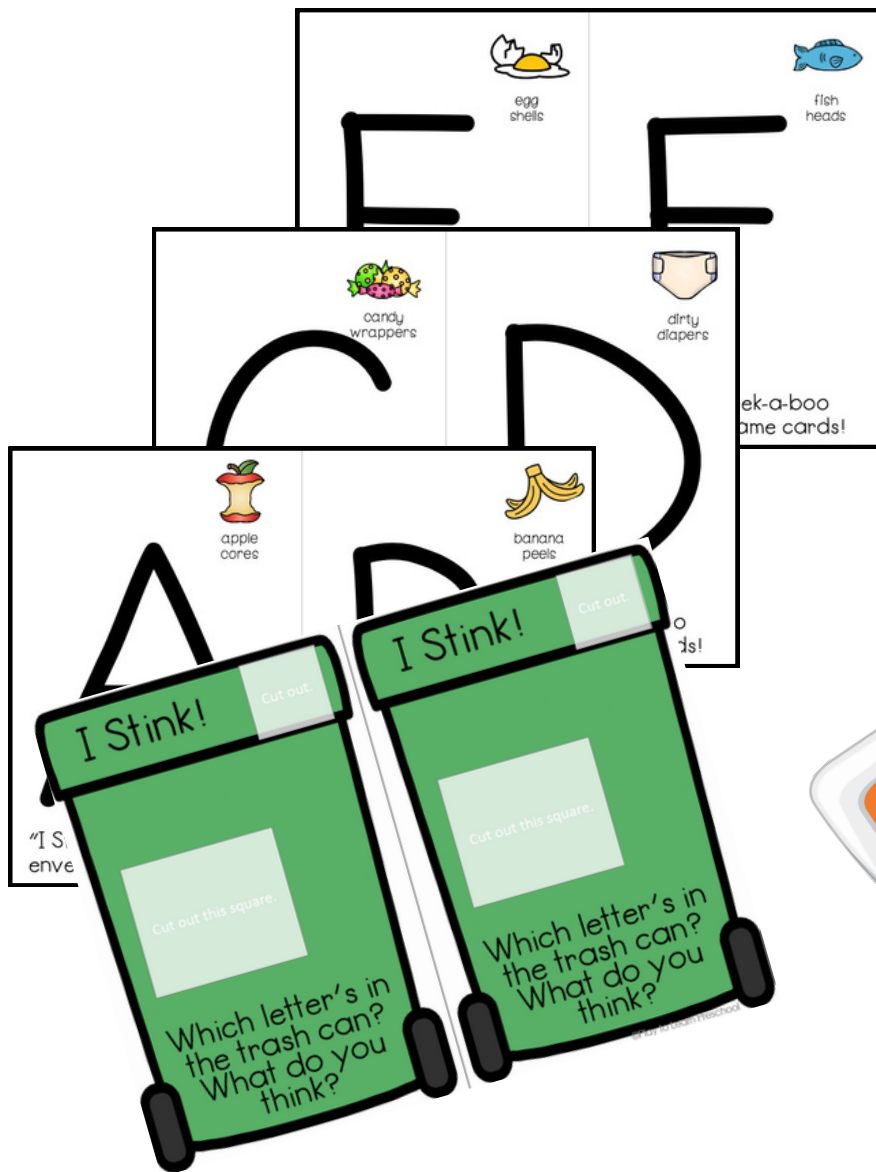


Beginning sound pictures help emergent readers make letter-sound connections.

# BEGINNING SOUND PRACTICE

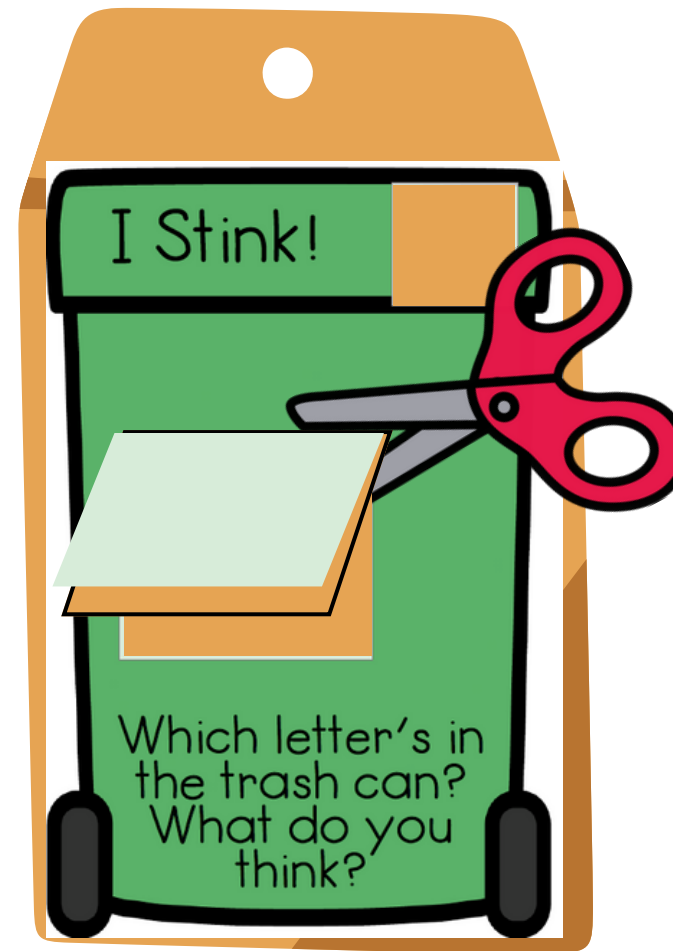
1. Print



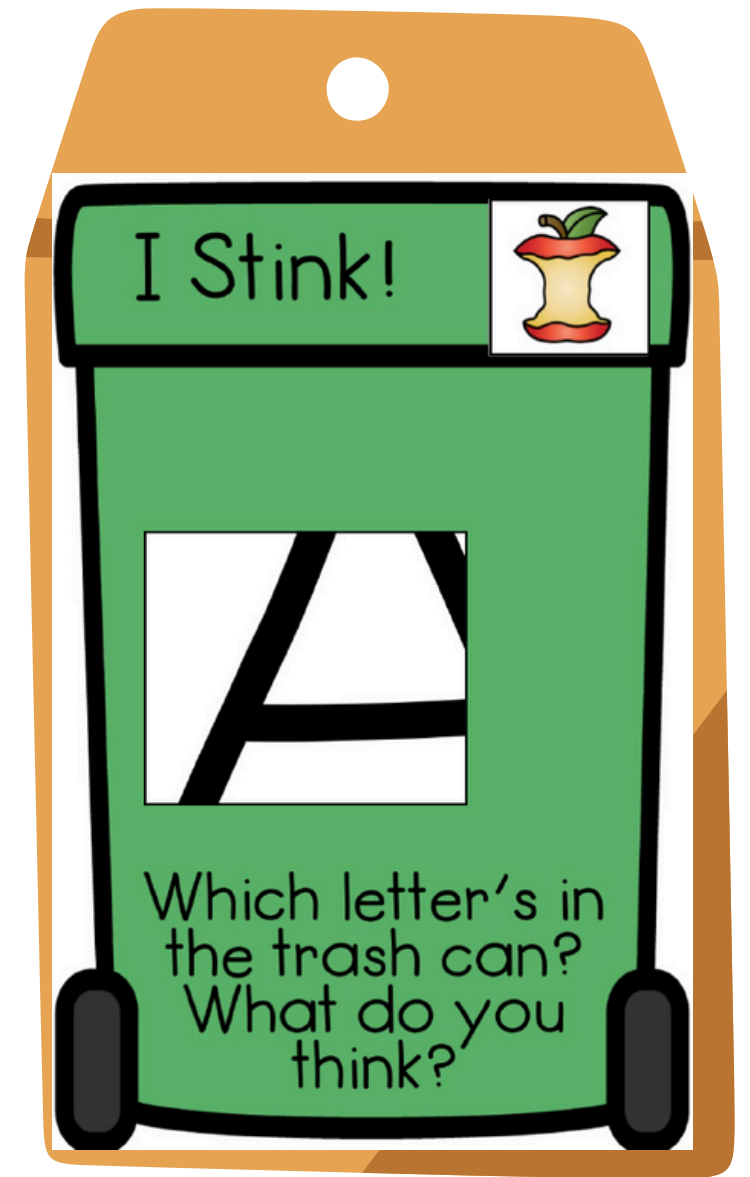
2. Glue the cover to a 6x9 envelope.
