

Pumpkin Beginning Sounds

Children match pictures to beginning sounds and identify letters with this fun pumpkin-themed activity. Perfect for preschool and kindergarten.

Learning Objectives:

Beginning Sounds and Letter Recognition – Students will identify uppercase and lowercase letters A-Z and their beginning sounds.

Fine Motor Development – Students will develop fine motor skills as they handle, align, and match the cards.

Preparation:

- **Print** the pages on standard paper or cardstock for durability.
- **Laminate** the sheets for reuse.
- **Cut** along the lines to create individual cards.
- **Attach** the smaller cards to clothespins for fine motor practice.

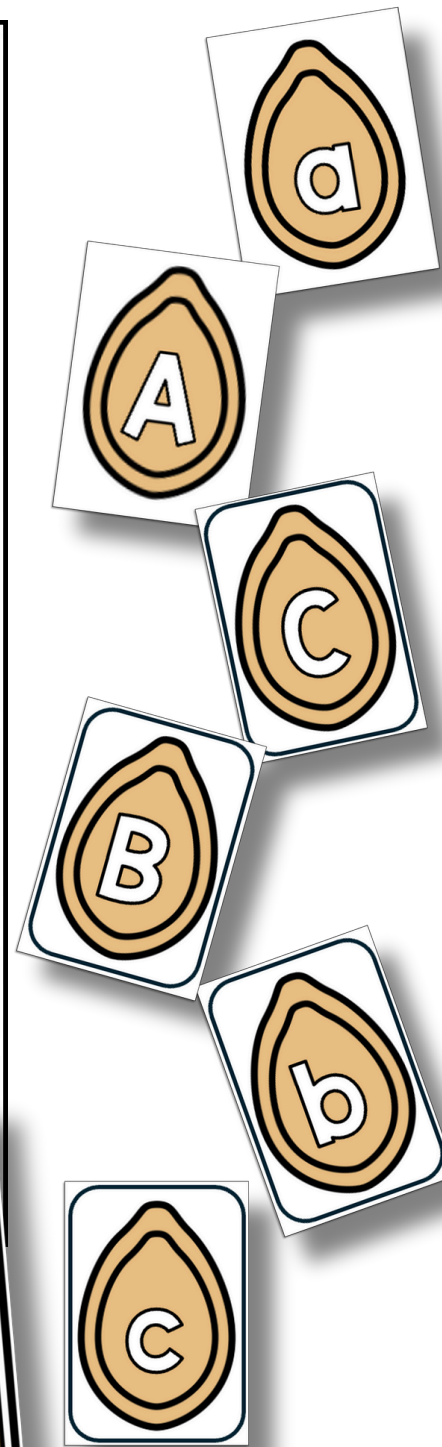
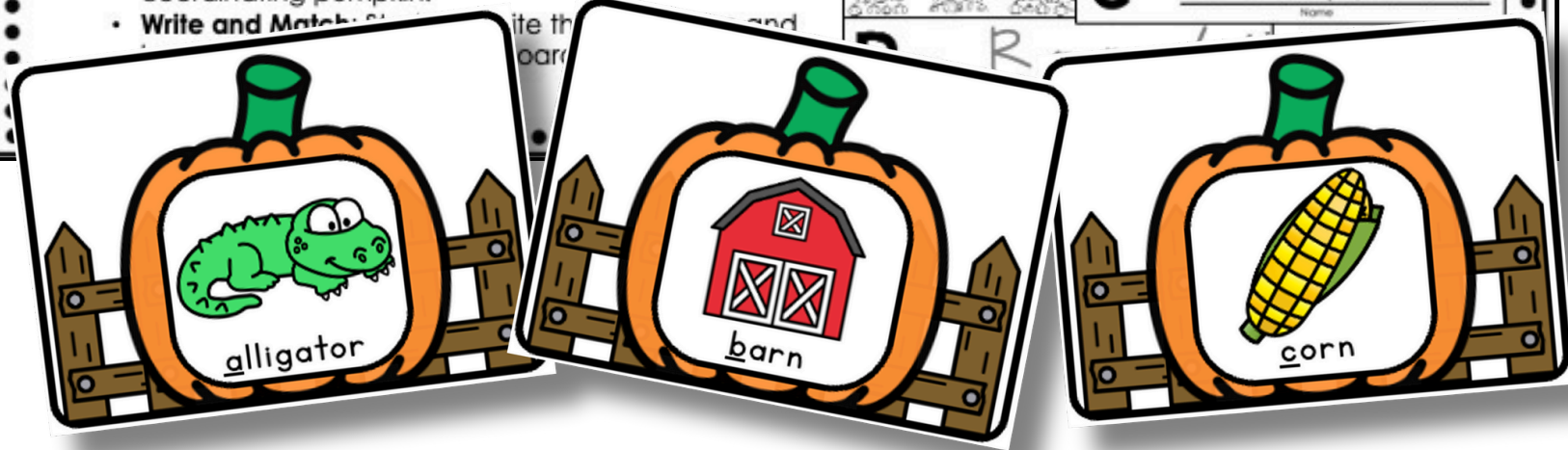
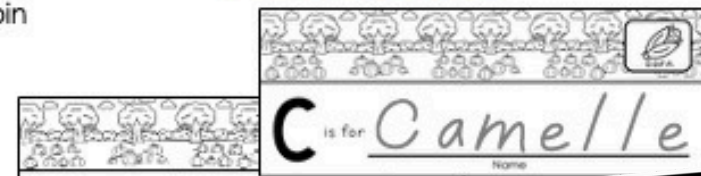
How to Use:

Pumpkin Cards - Students look at the pumpkin picture card, then find the matching lettered seed.

Name Strips - Print out a beginning letter name strip for each student. Student writes their name, then colors the picture.

Other Fun Uses:

- **Sensory Bin Match:** Fill a plastic pumpkin with tan crinkle paper and add the seed cards. Students search the bin for the letters to match the pumpkin mats.
- **Alphabetical Order:** Students arrange the seeds in alphabetical order before matching them with the coordinating pumpkin.
- **Write and Match:** Students write the beginning letter of the word on the pumpkin mat and match the seed card.

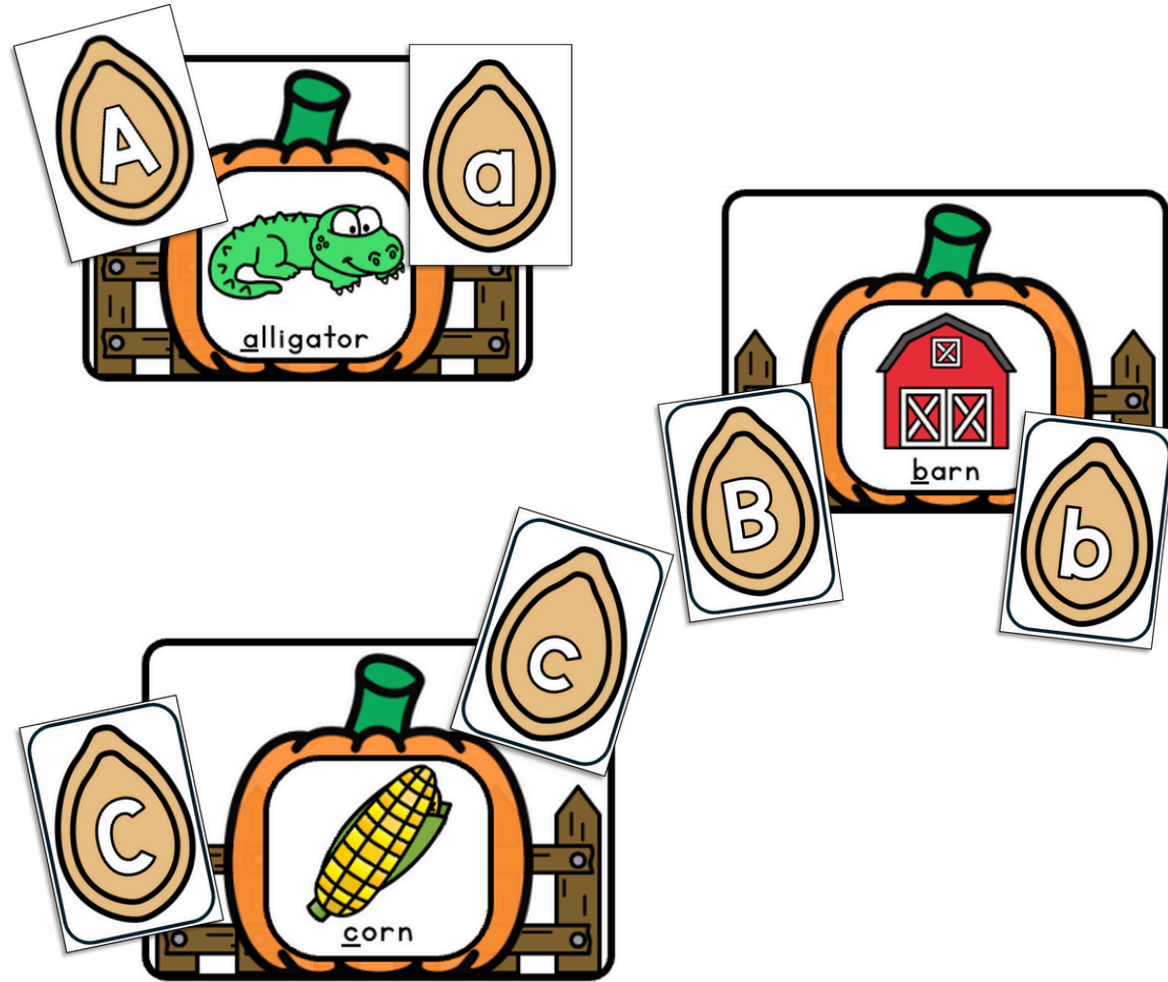
