

Pumpkin Letter Tracing Mats

These tracing cards provide structured, visual support to help young learners practice forming uppercase and lowercase letters correctly. With starting points, directional arrows, and dashed lines, each card breaks down the writing process into manageable steps.

Learning Objectives

Letter Recognition & Formation – Identify and form uppercase and lowercase letters A–Z.

Fine Motor Development – Strengthen pencil grip, hand control, and coordination.

Preparation:

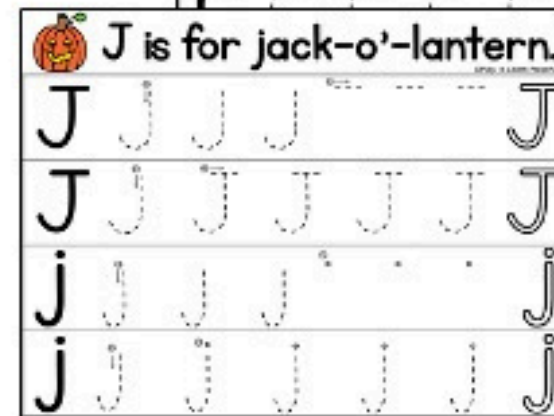
- **Print** the pages on cardstock for durability.
- **Laminate** the pages or place each one in a dry-erase sleeve for reuse.
- **Provide** dry-erase markers for tracing.

How to Use:

1. Introduce each letter by tracing the letters together. Encourage students to trace over the dashed lines using the numbered starting points and following the arrows.
2. Students trace both uppercase and lowercase lines to reinforce letter recognition and formation.
3. Erase and practice again!

Other Engaging Uses:

- **Centers:** Add to literacy centers or morning work routine.
- **Small Groups** Using during handwriting support sessions.
- **Assessment Tool** Observe letter formation and fine motor development over time.



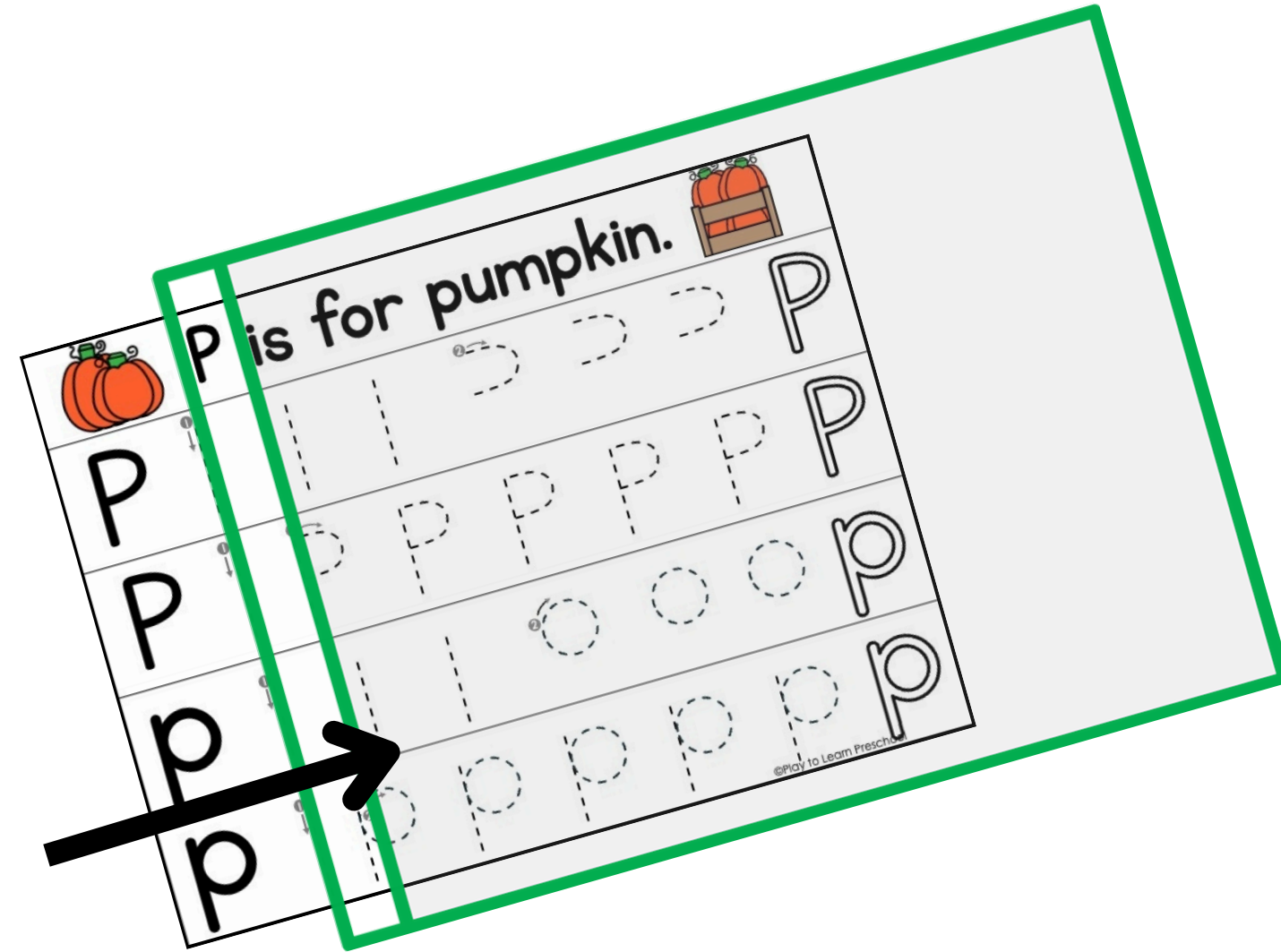
