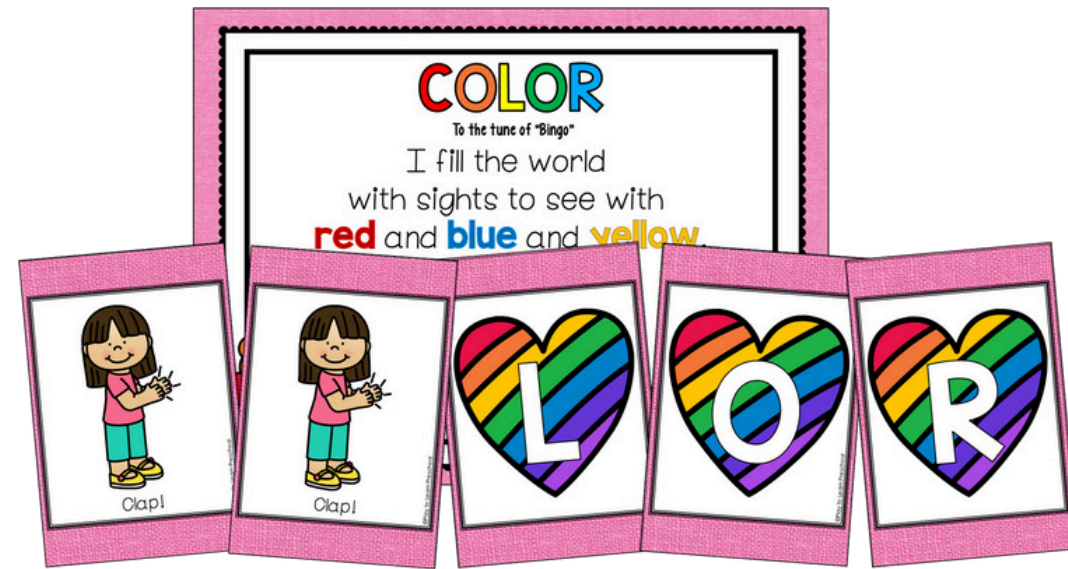

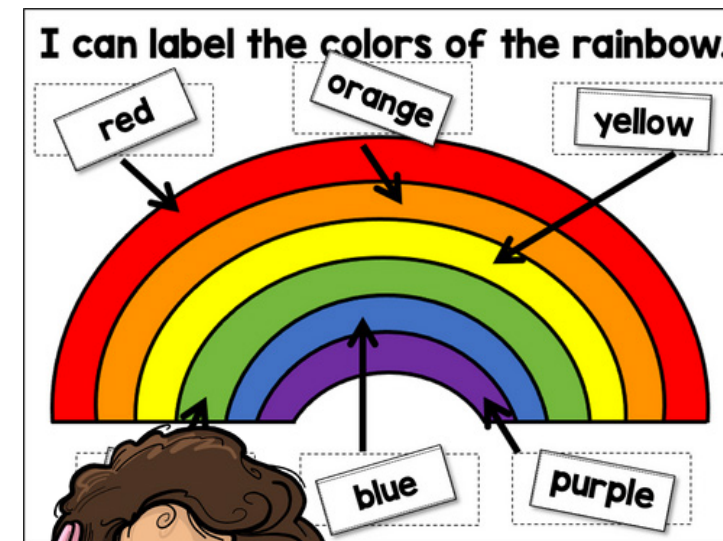

CENTER ACTIVITIES

Cutting Practice

Fine Motor Center

Objective: The students coordinate eye-hand movement and control the small muscles in their hands.

Preparation: Print a cutting page for each student. Demonstrate proper scissors usage and guide students to cut along the lines from the bottom to the top.

Procedure: The students will cut along the dotted lines the bottom of the page to the top.

Line Tracing

Literacy Center

Objective: The students will understand the purpose of writing.

Preparation: Print and laminate these tracing cards. Another option is to place them inside a plastic sleeve. Provide dry erase markers. (Glue a pom-pom onto the lid of the marker for the students to use as an eraser.)

Procedure: Trace the lines.

Rhyming Rainbows

Literacy Center

Objective: The students identify rhyming words.

Preparation: Copy each puzzle, laminate and cut apart.

Procedure: Students say the name of the picture on the left side of the rainbow and find the rhyming picture on the right side of the rainbow.

Writing Practice

Literacy Center

Objectives: The students will write letters.

Preparation: Copy each page and place into a plastic sleeve (or print on cardstock and laminate).

Procedure: Students use a dry erase marker to trace the word.

Journaling

Literacy Center

Objective: The students will understand the purpose of writing.

Preparation: Print the journal sheets. Students can use the journal prompts to write and draw a picture. The words can also be written for the student if necessary.

Count and Clip Cards

Math Center

Objective: Students will practice one-to-one correspondence and number recognition to 12.

Preparation: Print the cards, mat, laminate and cut apart.

Procedure: Students count the pictures on each card and mark the correct answer with a clothes pin.

Math Center

File Folder Game

Objective: The students will count and recognize numbers.

Preparation: Copy the picture cards. Glue the large pictures (first 2 pages) inside a file folder. Cut and laminate the smaller pictures.

Procedure: Students will count and choose the correct number.

Beginning Sound Sort

Literacy Center

File Folder Game

Objectives: The students will identify the beginning sound of each word.

Preparation: Copy the picture cards. Glue the cover on the front of the file folder and the sorting mats on the inside. Cut and laminate the smaller pieces.

Procedure: Students sort the pictures by their beginning sound.

Color Sorting

Math Center

Objective: The students will sort food pictures by color onto the matching colored plates.

Preparation: Print the colored plates or use the black and white plate to copy to colored paper. Print, laminate and cut apart the food pictures.

Procedure: Students look at the food and identify its color. They place the foods onto the matching plate.

Concentration

Working Memory

Objectives: The students will use visual discrimination (matching) skills to identify two identical objects.

Preparation: Print the picture cards. Mat onto cardstock and/or laminate as desired. Cut apart.

Procedure: Place cards facing down. Students take turns flipping over 2 cards at a time. If the cards match, the student gets to keep the pair. If they don't match, they return them to the face-down position and try again.


