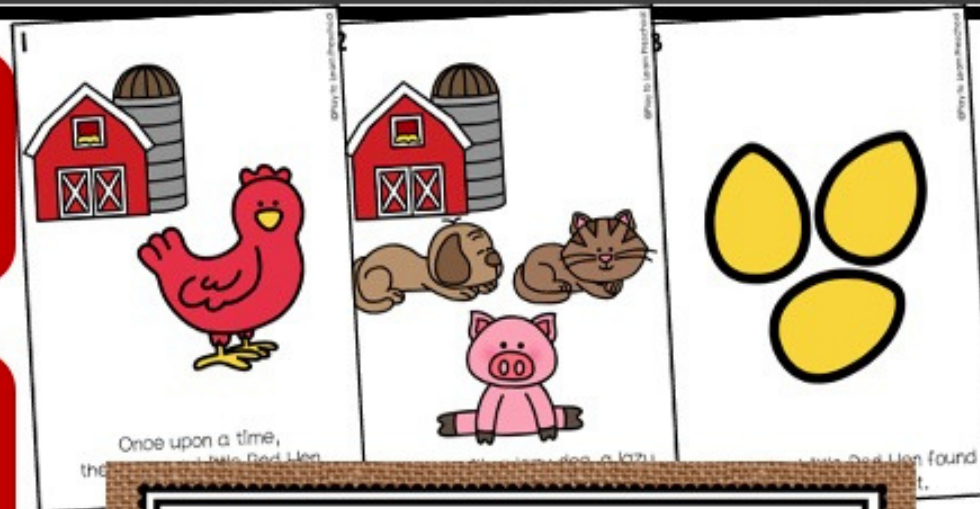

Bread in a Bag

Recipe

3 c. all purpose flour
3 Tbsp. white sugar
1 - .25 ounce package rapid rise yeast
1 c. warm water
3 Tbsp. olive oil
1 1/2 tsp. salt

In a resealable plastic bag, place 1 c. flour, sugar, and yeast. Seal the bag and mix together with your hands. Let rest 5 minutes. Add 1 c. flour, oil, and salt to bag, seal and mix. Add last ingredient and knead. Turn dough out onto a floured surface and roll out. Cut into two 4x6 inch loaves. Place in two mini loaf pans. Cover with a damp cloth and let rise for 30 minutes. Bake in a 375° oven for 25 - 30 minutes.

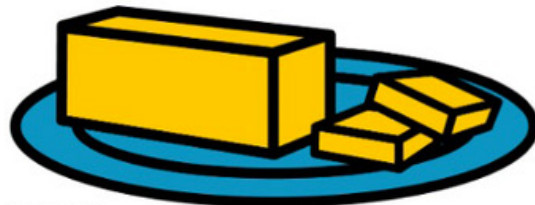


S.T.E.M. ACTIVITIES

- salt



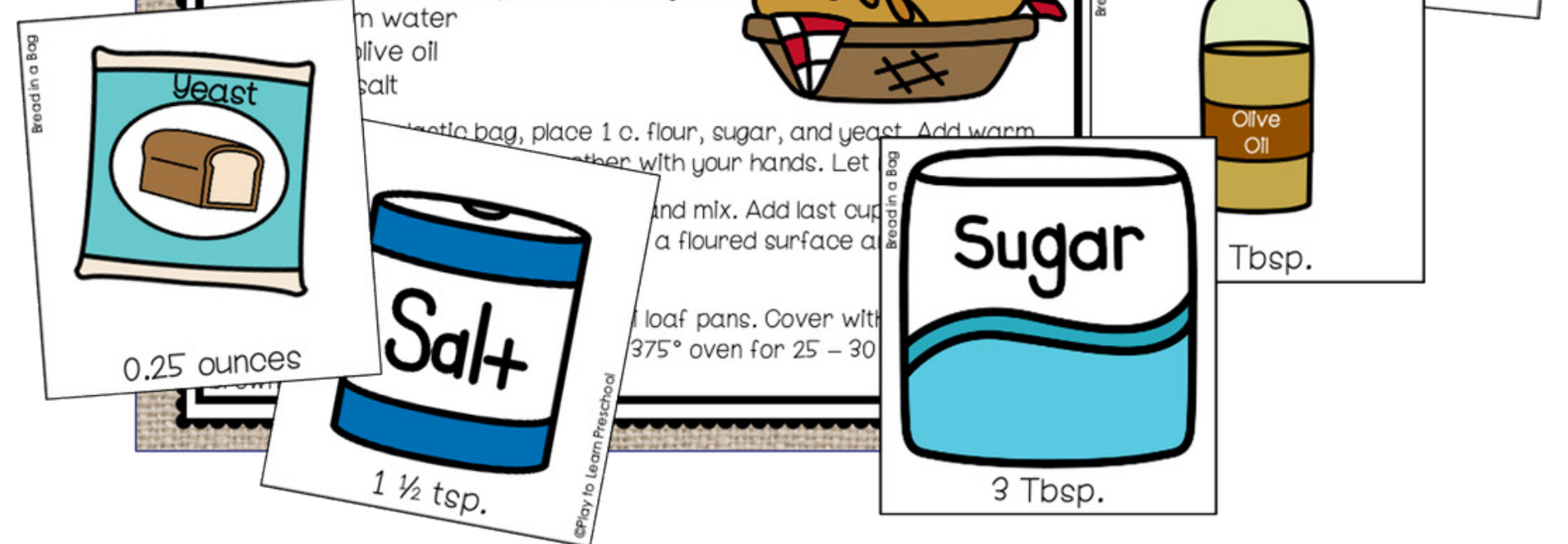
1. Fill a small plastic jar or container approximately 1/3 of the way full of cream.
